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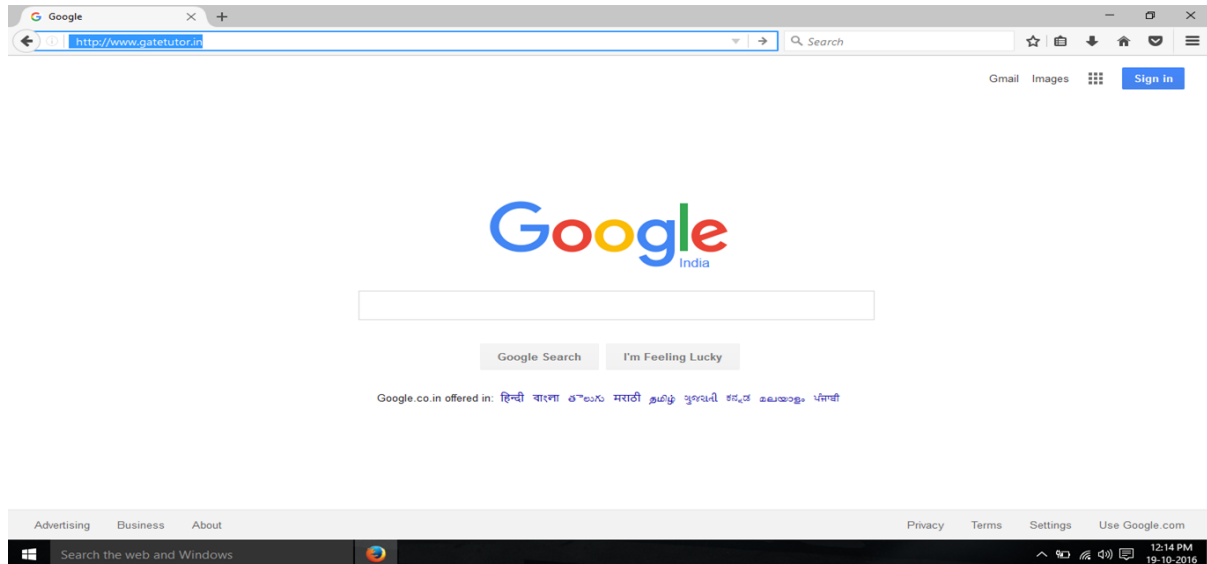
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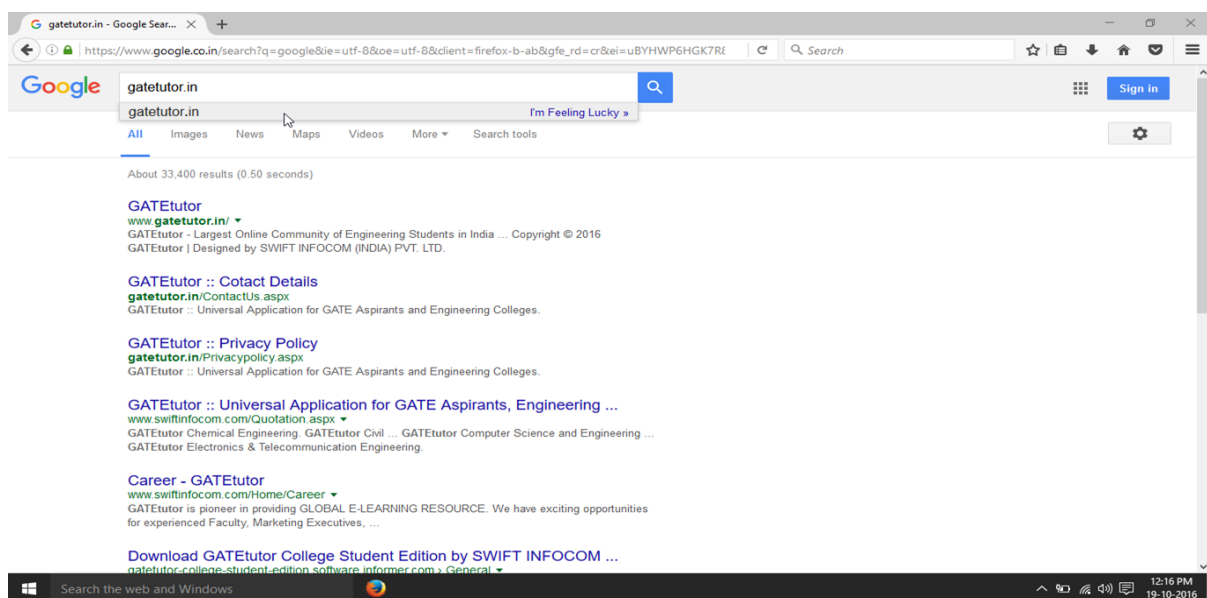
I. How to register on GATetutor.in

3. **Pass out student**

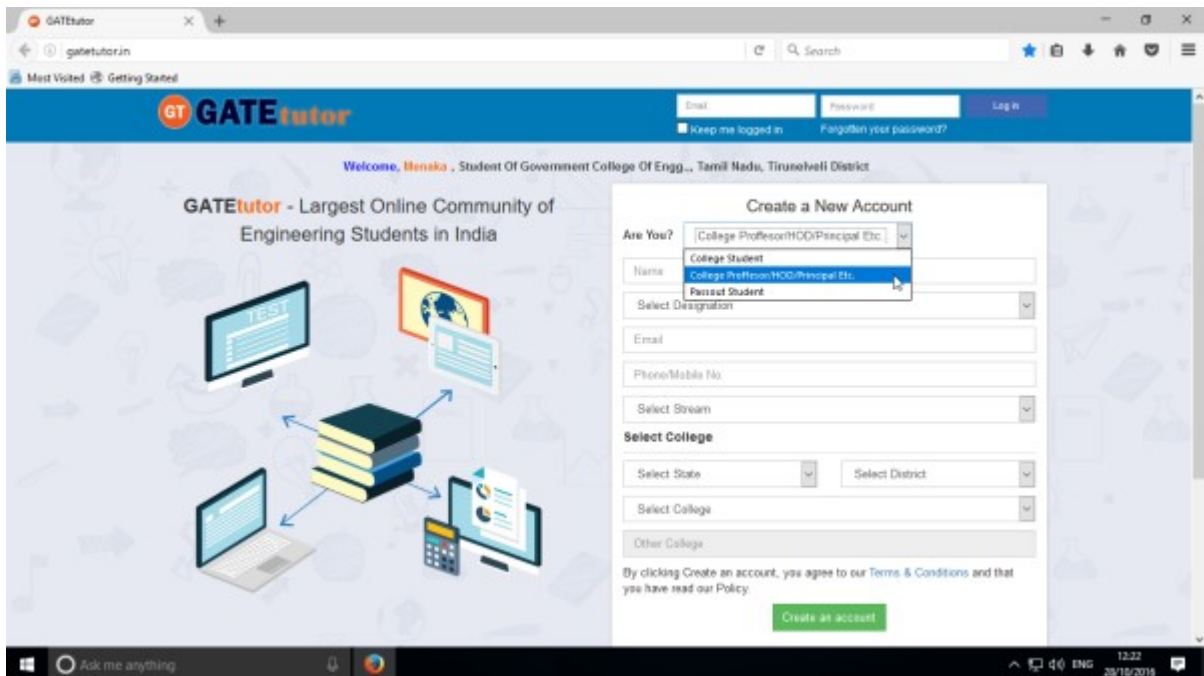

If you want to register as a “College Admin”, click on second menu from drop down list. Following screen will appear



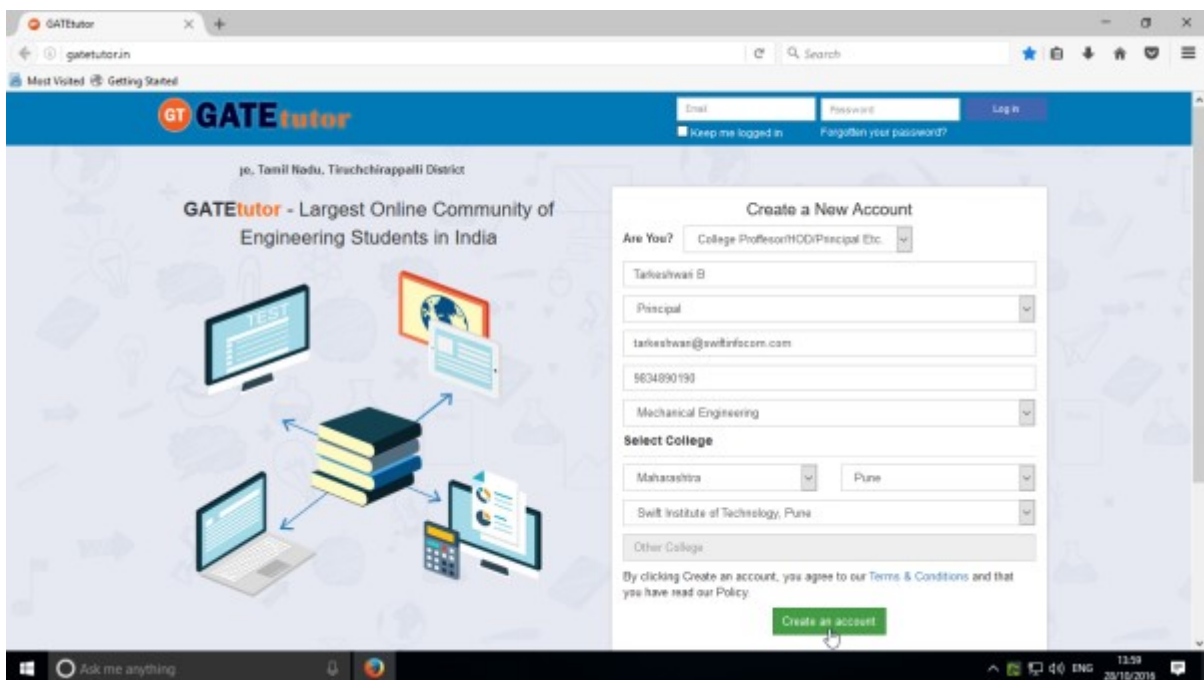

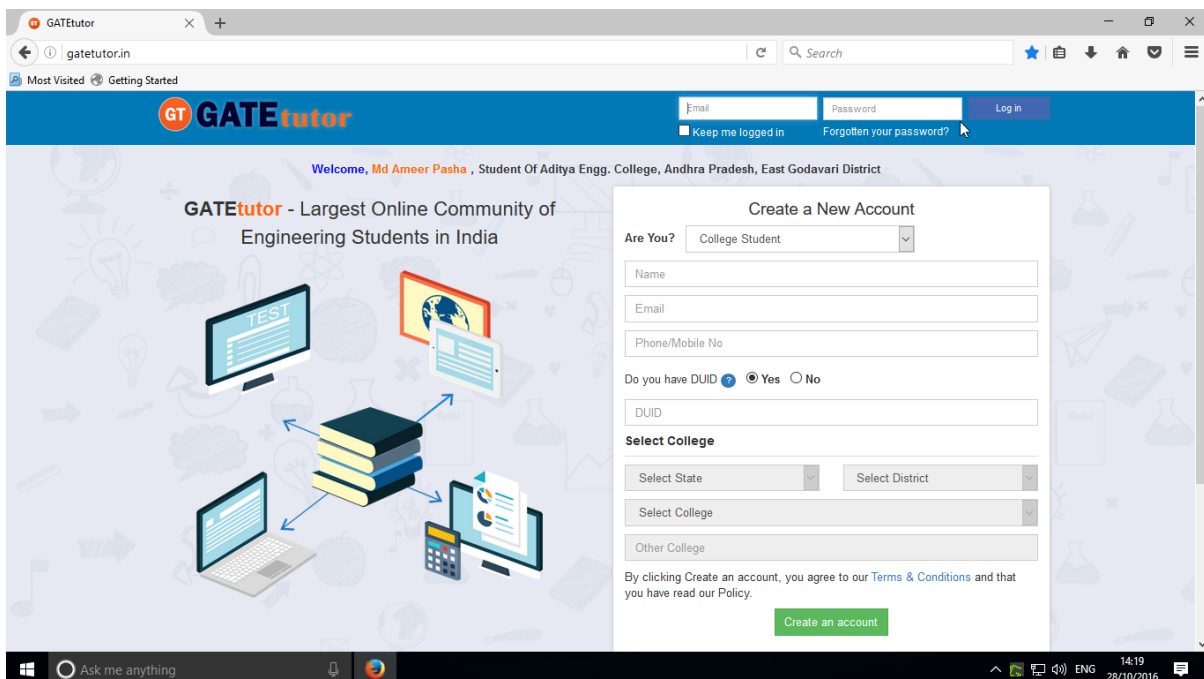
Step 1(2) Registration Details

After registering successfully your **User id** and **Password** will be sent to that email-id which you have provided at the time of registration.

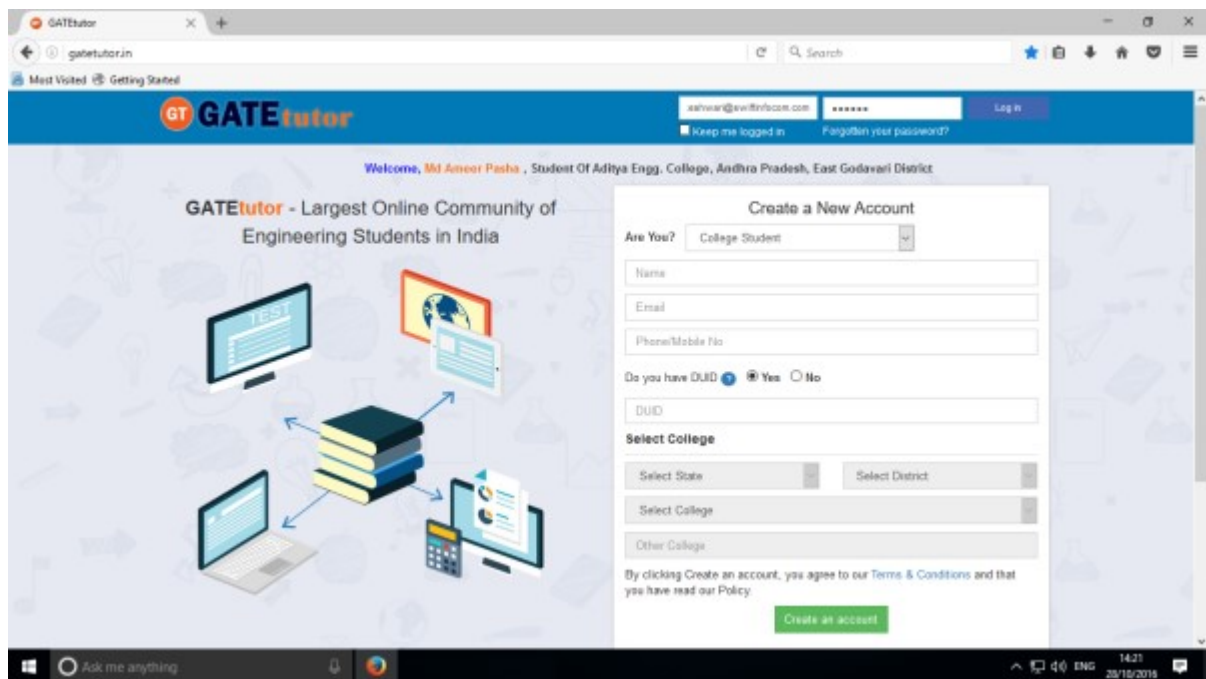

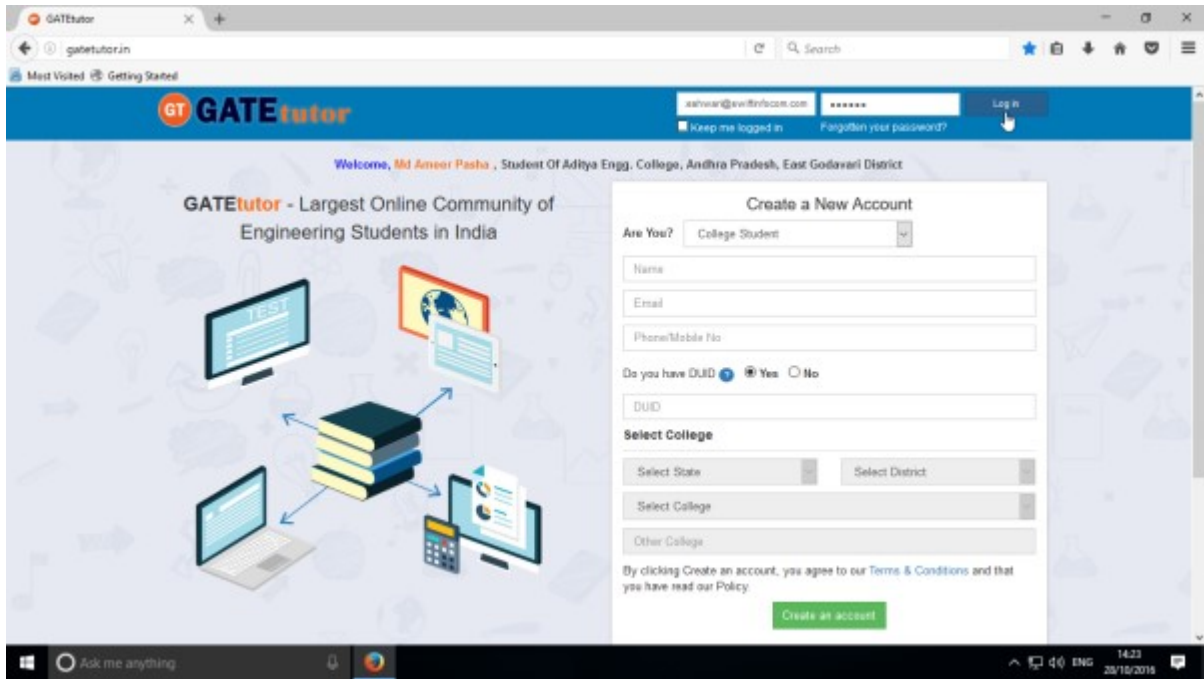

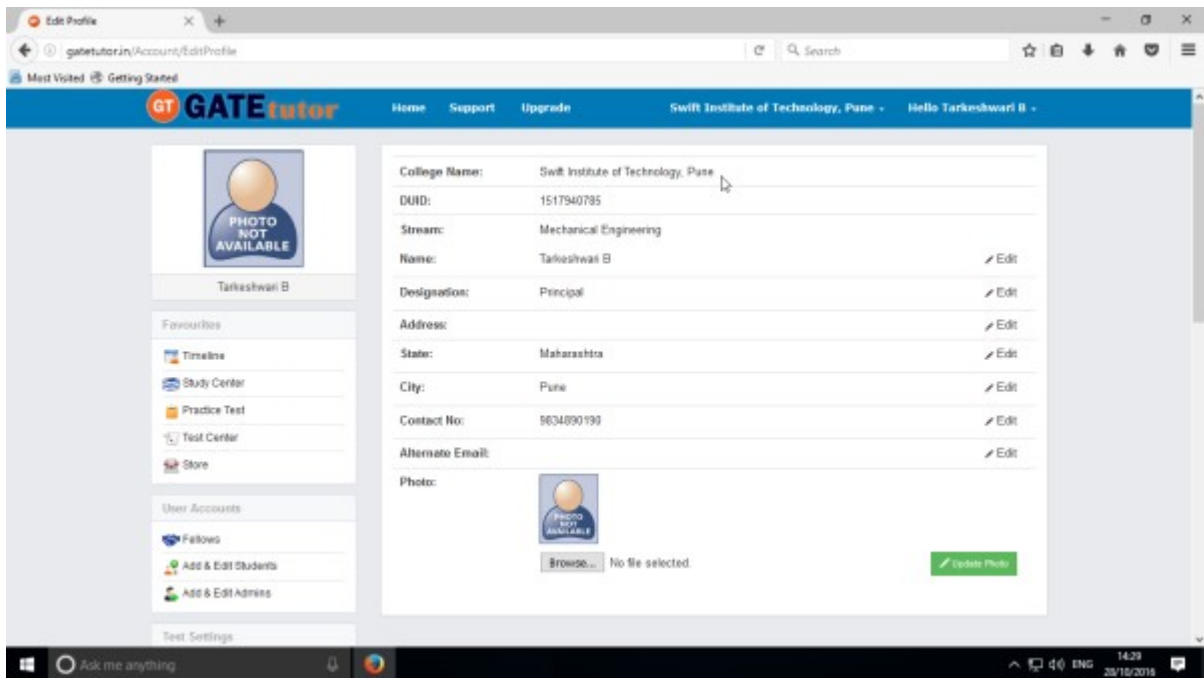

Enter registered **Email-ID** and **Password** & Click on **“Log in”**

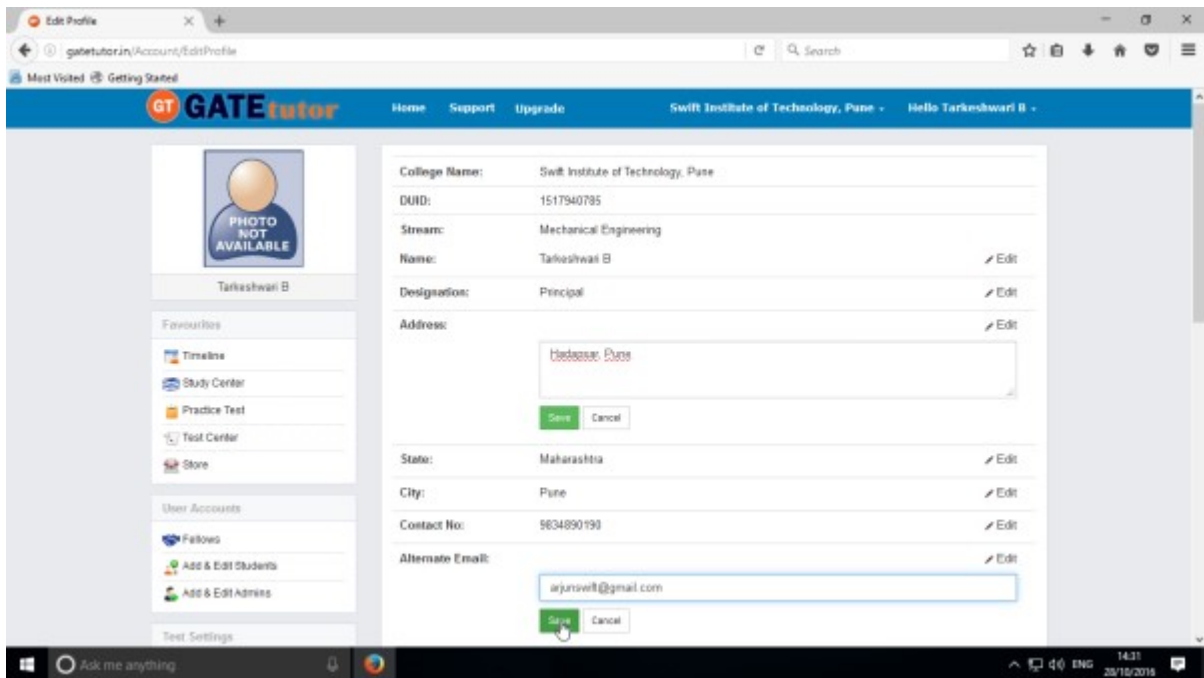

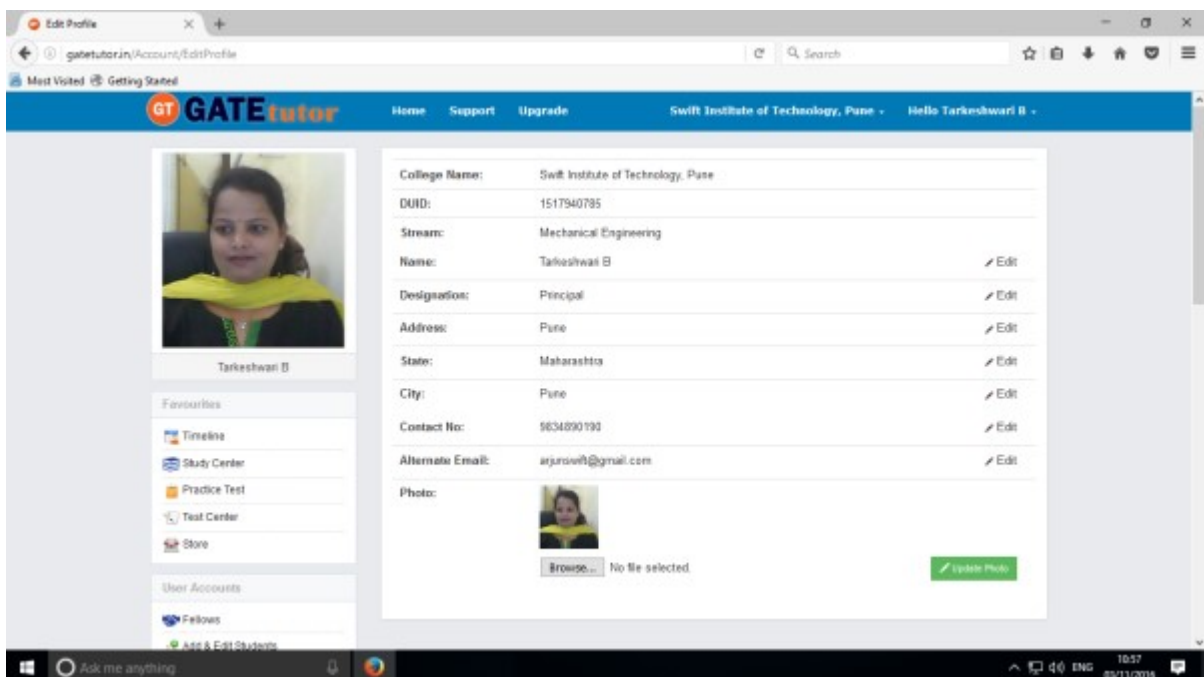


a) Edit Profile

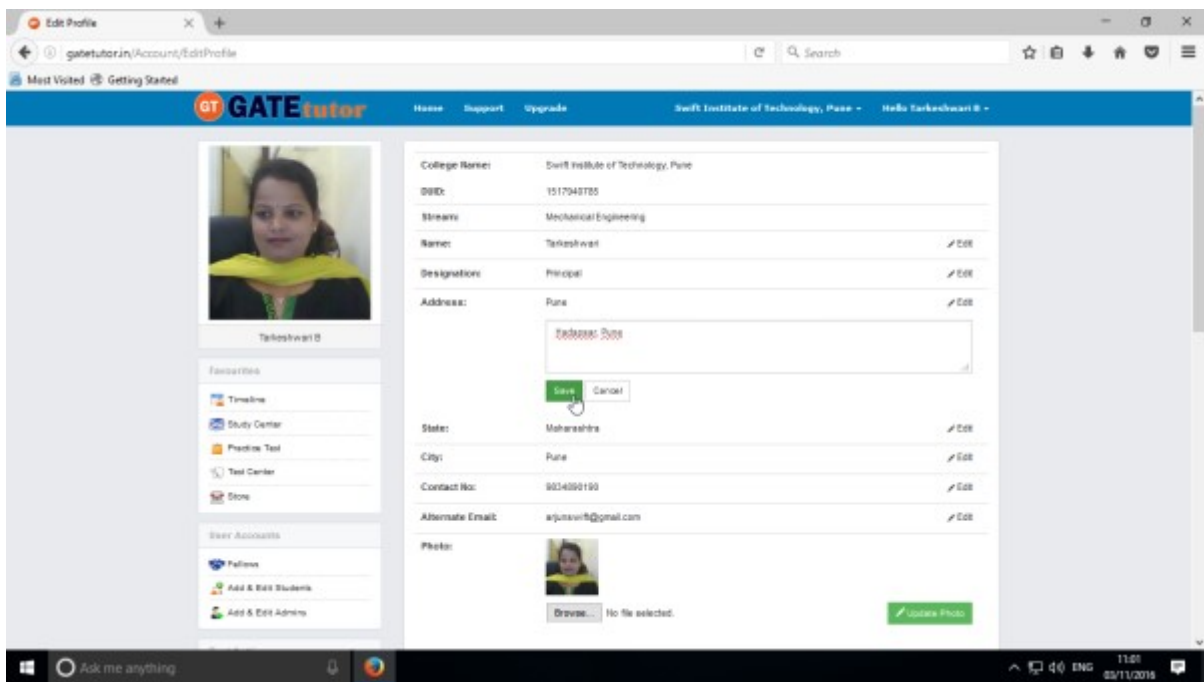


When you click on “Edit Profile” you will appear a page as follows

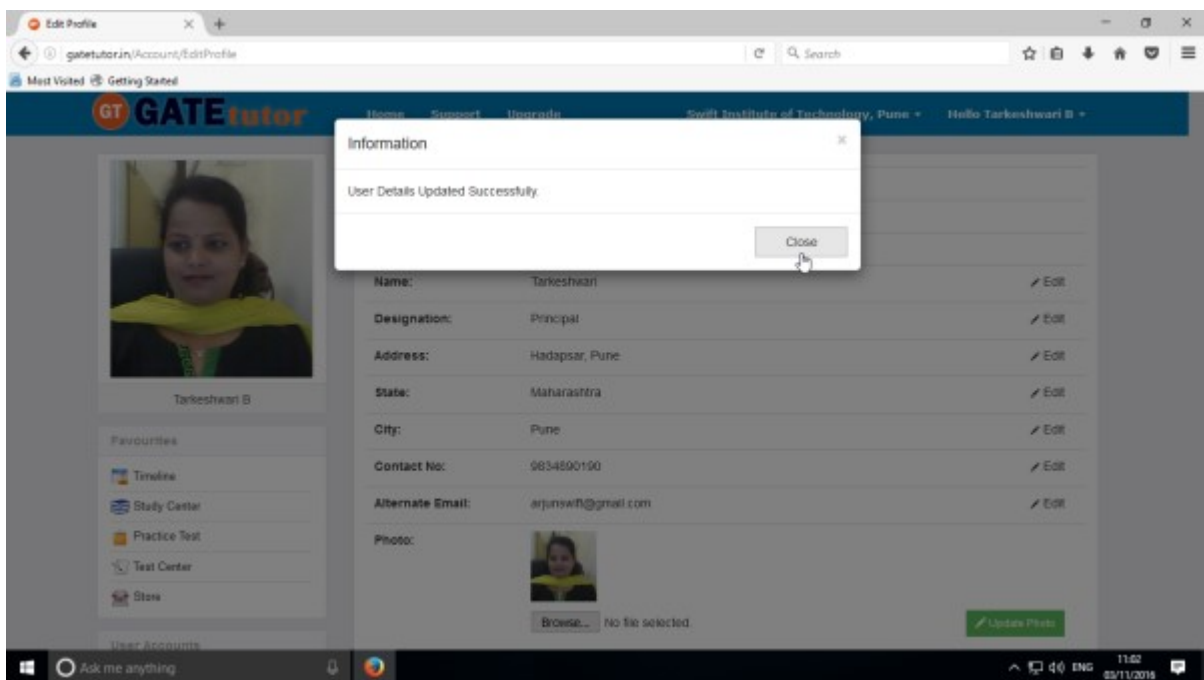


Choose the options to change or edit.

Here, you can make changes by clicking on “Edit” option

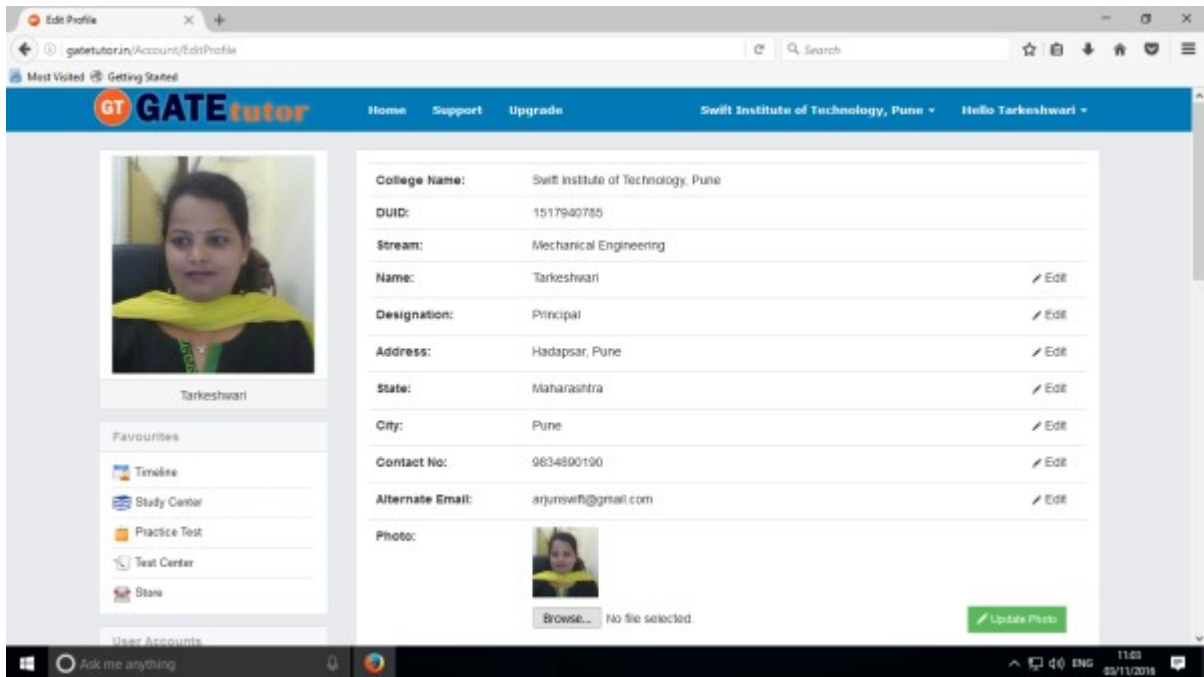


After clicking on “Save” button, you will appear the following window & changes will be saved

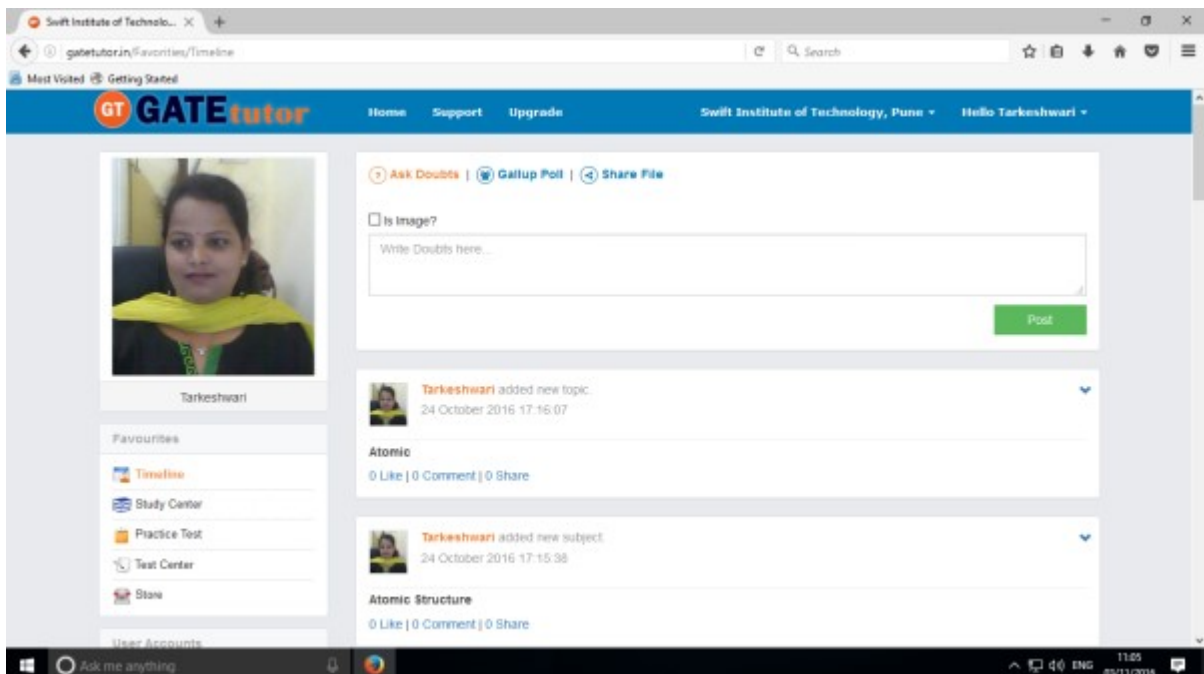


Your changes will be saved successfully. Now click on “Close” to continue.

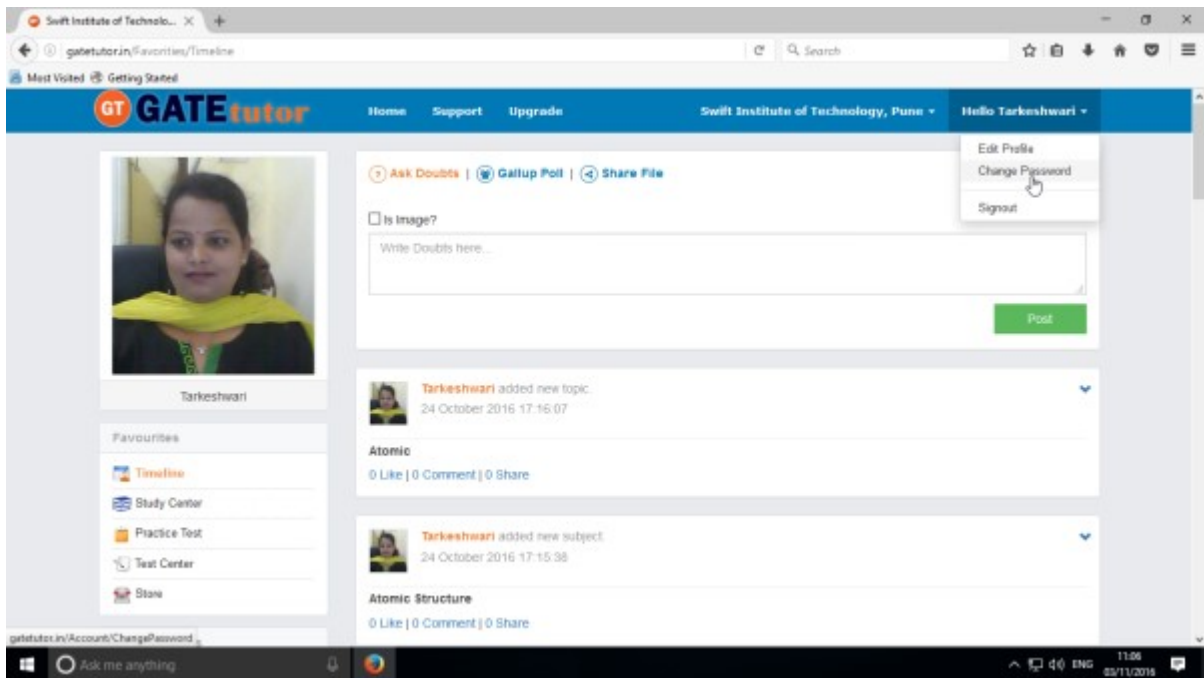
You can see the changes that you have done in your profile. These changes will appear in a profile.



You can see the changes done in profile. The main visible change in the profile after editing which is Profile picture on timeline

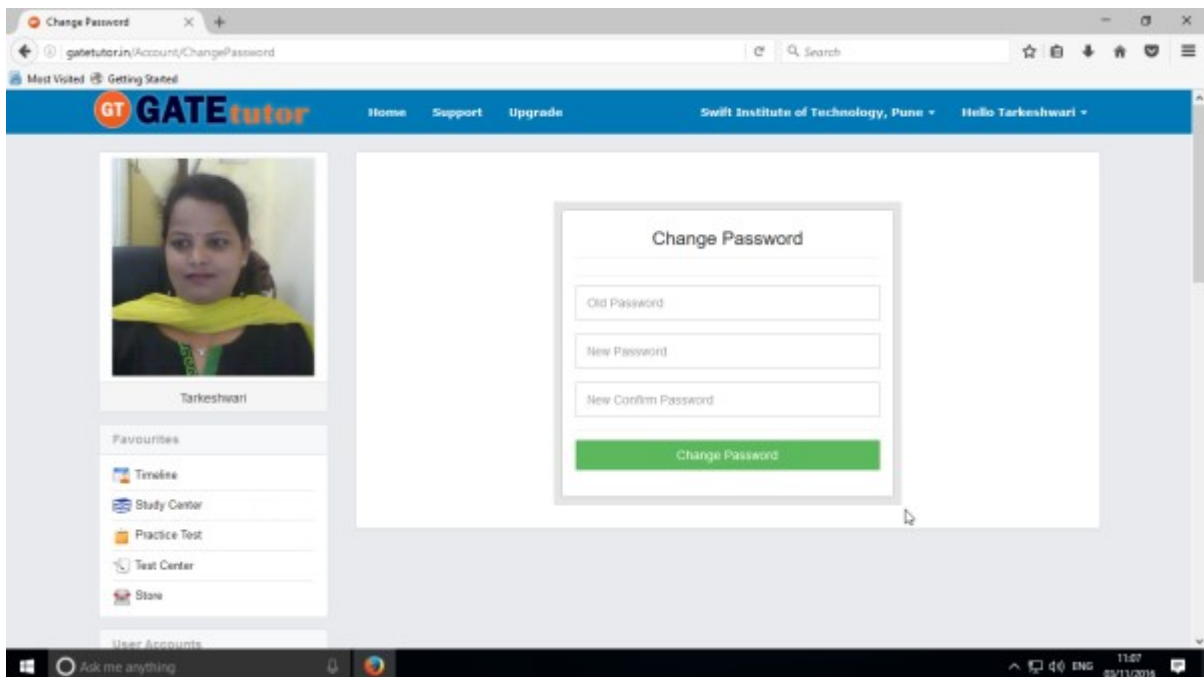


b) Change Password

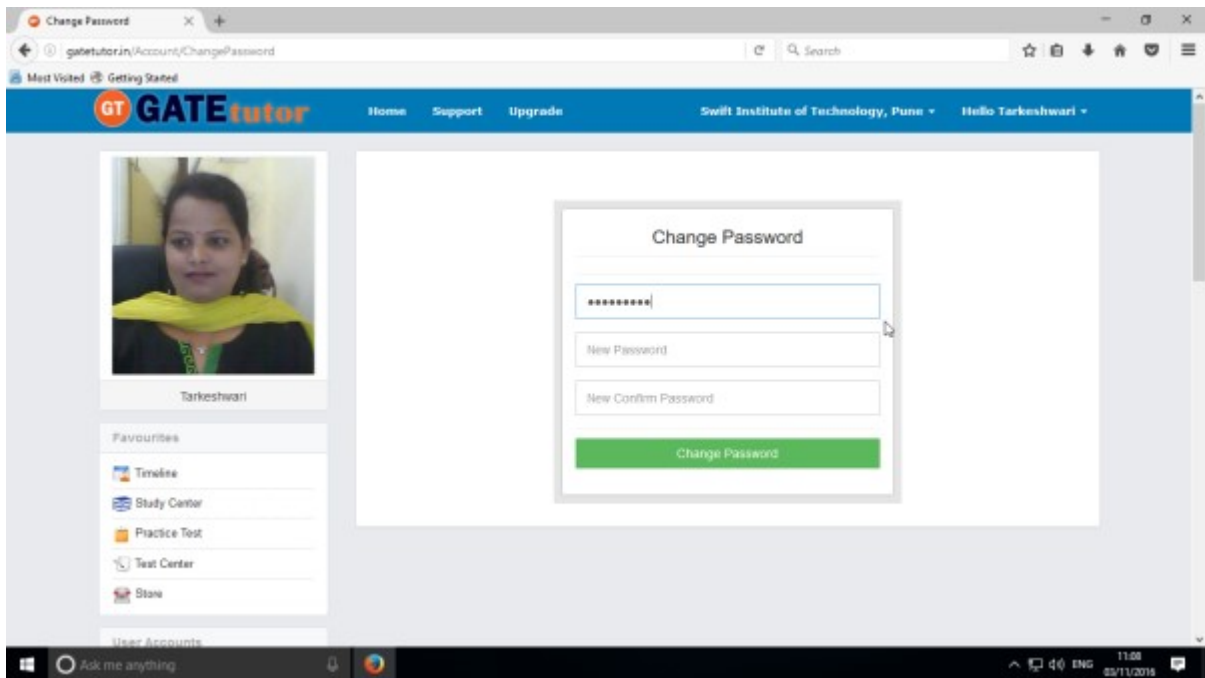


You get the password on your registered mail id from the GATEtutor when you register as a new user. You can use that password to login. You can also change that password by clicking on “**Change Password**” tab.

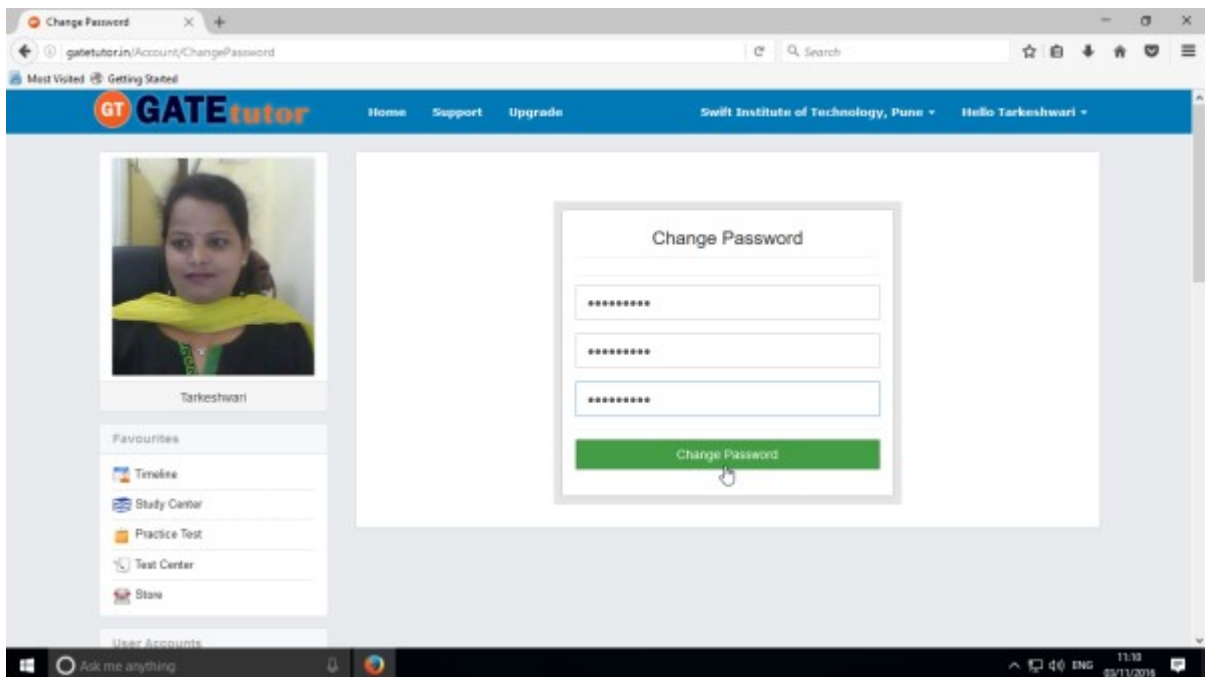
You will appear following window to change the password



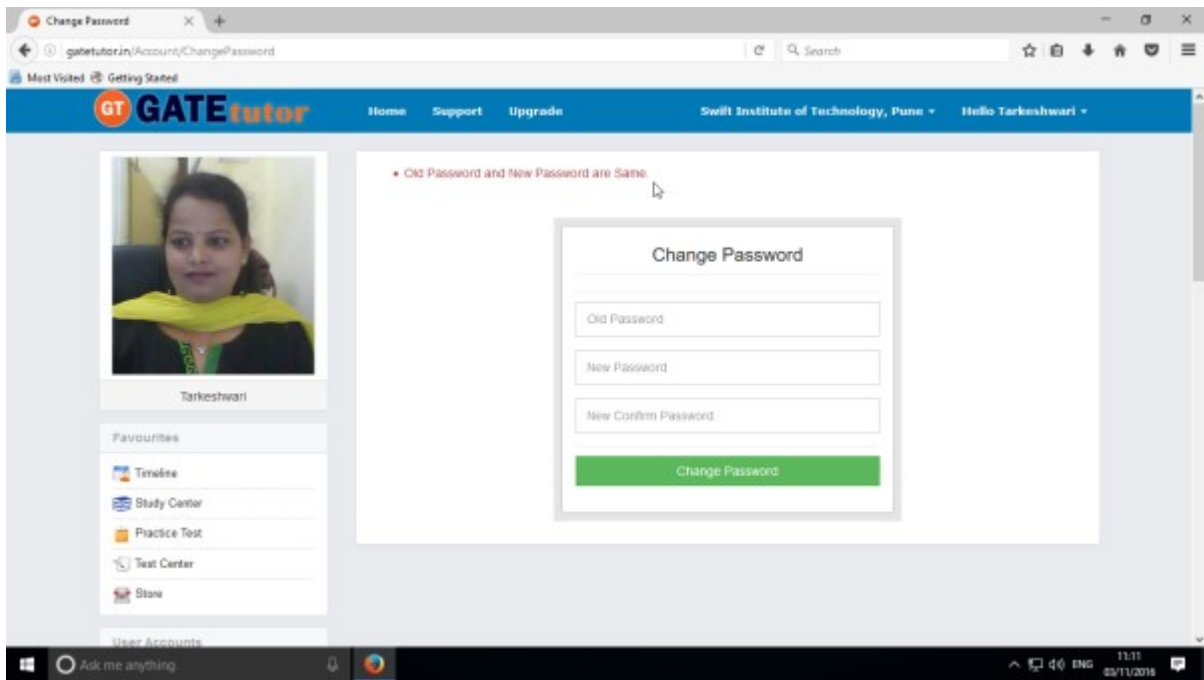
If you want to change the password then enter an old password in old password textbox



Enter an old password and new password then confirm new password

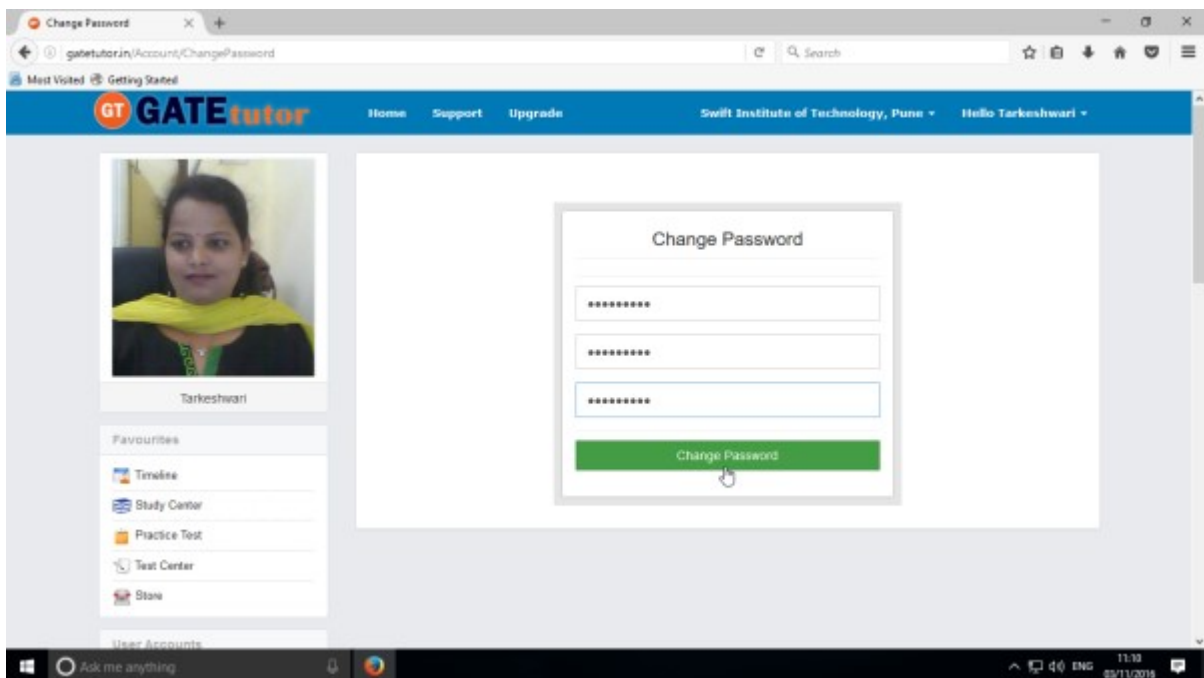


Click on **“Change Password”** as above

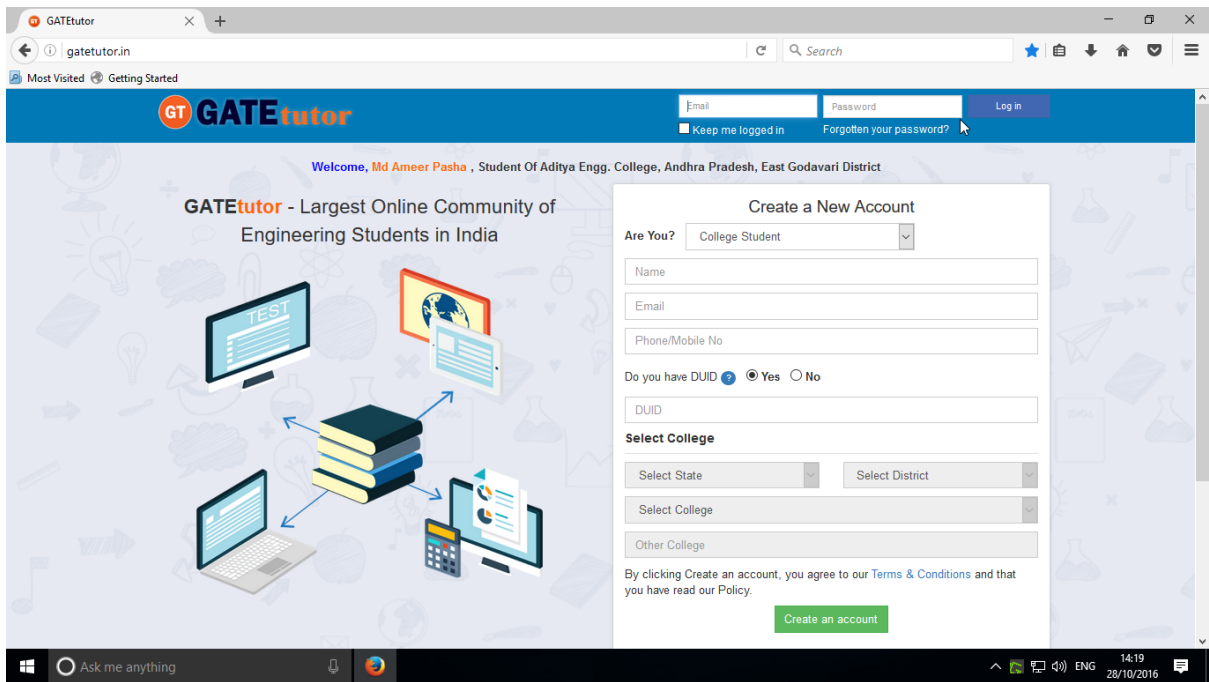


If the old password is used as new password, it shows the message that **“Old Password & New Password are same”**. You can't use old password as a new password.

Now, enter an email & new password to login to the GATEtutor.

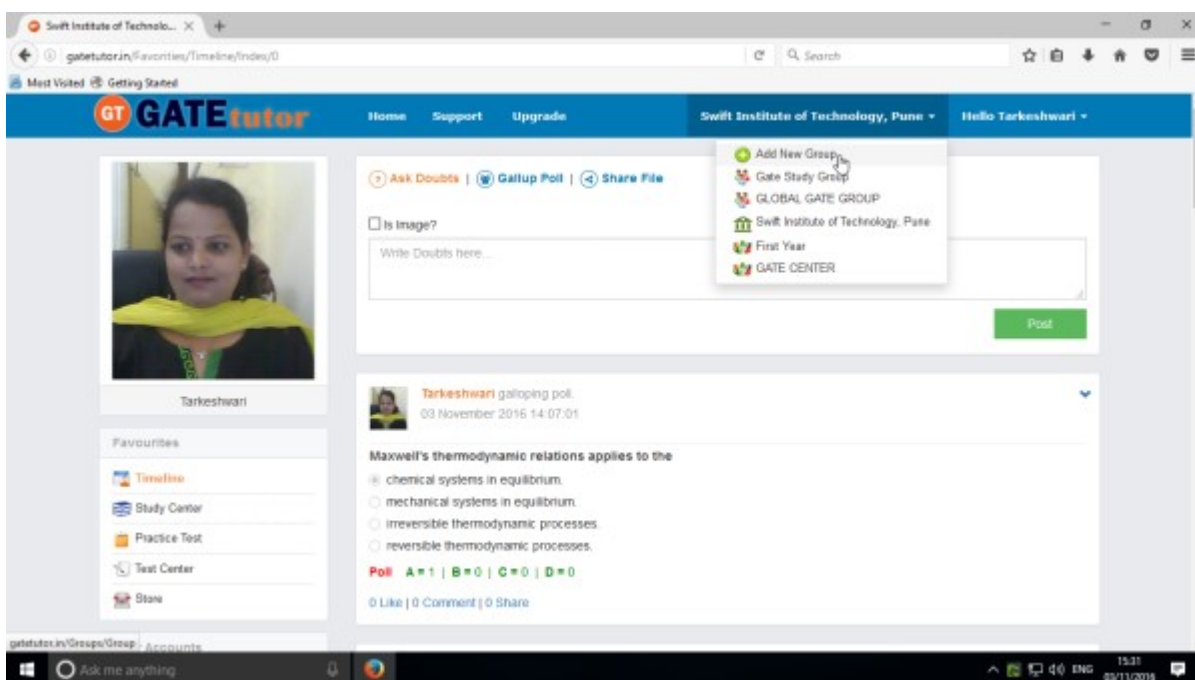
c) Study Groups

College Sub Group

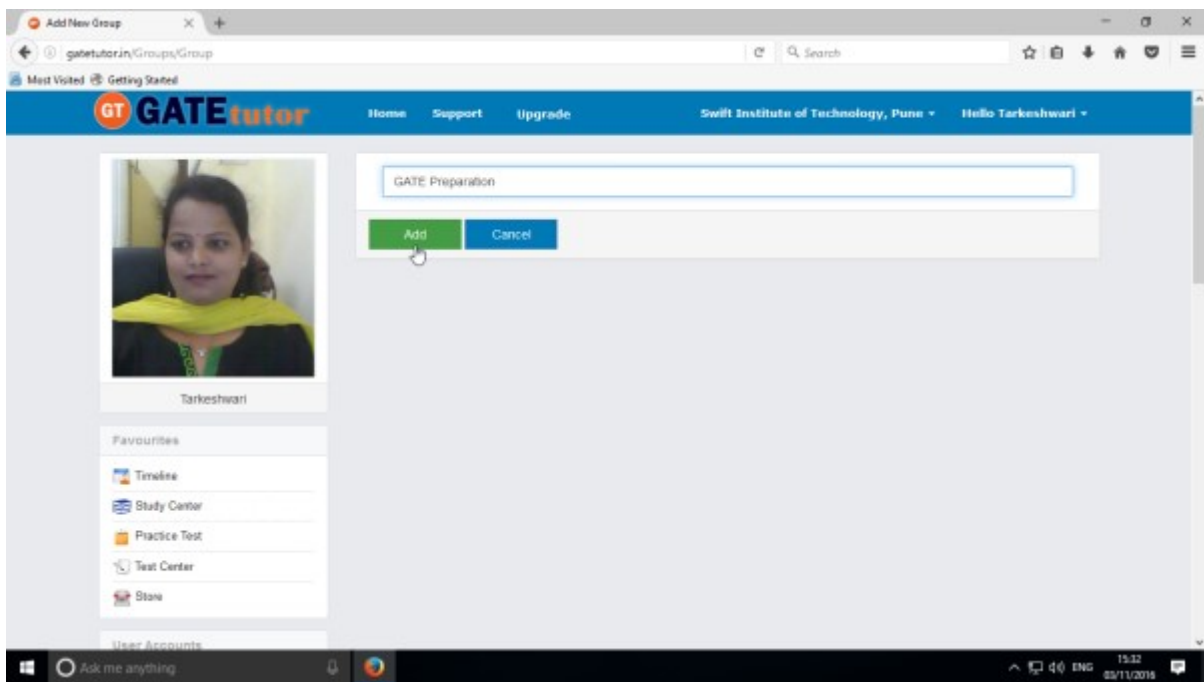

Go to your college name tab & click on it. You will appear the “**Add New Group**” menu as follows



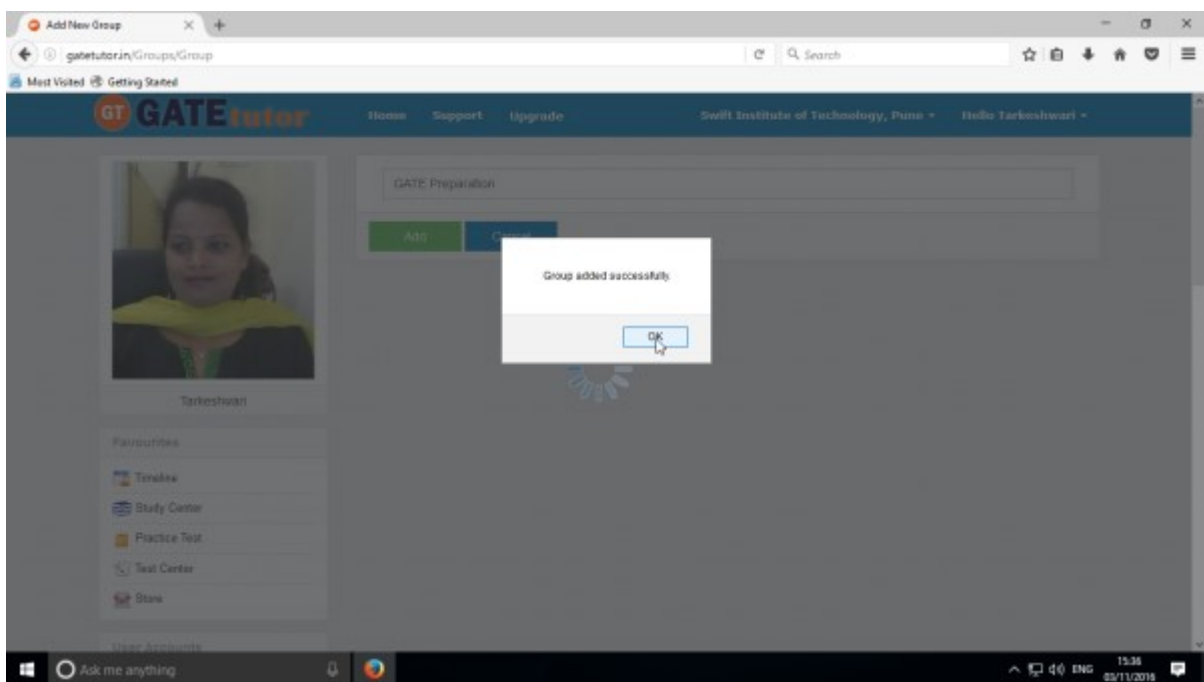
Click on the “**Add New Group**” to create a college sub group.

Enter the name of the group



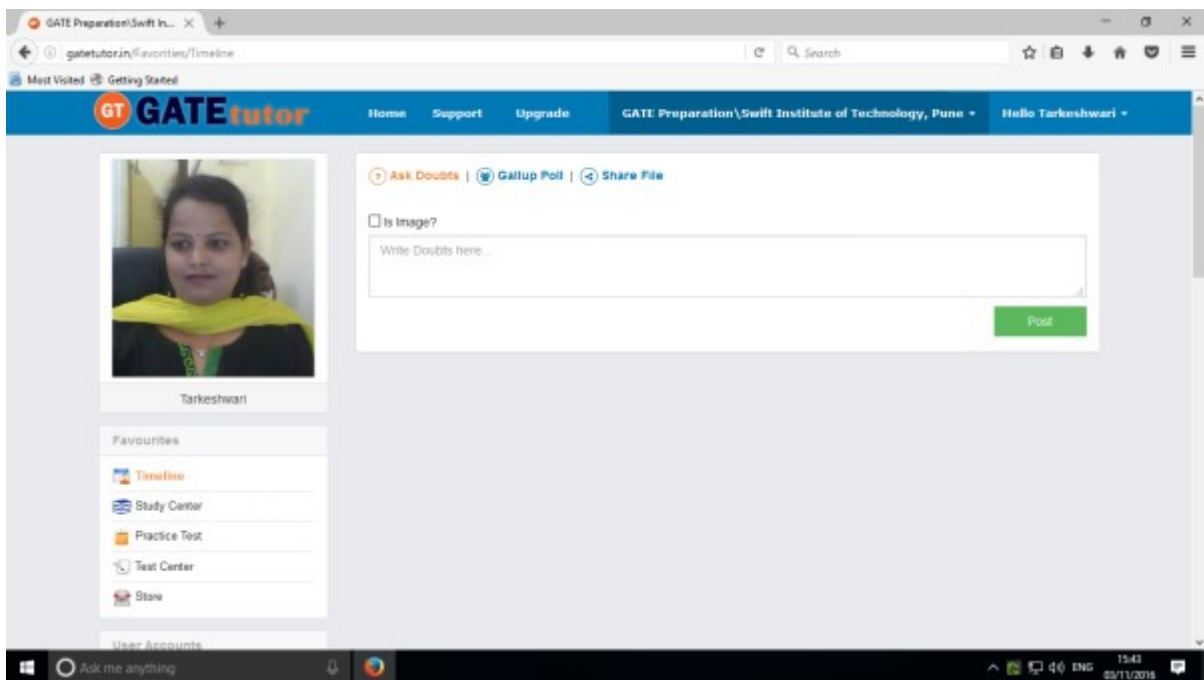
Click on **“Add”** to save the group.

New college sub group will get created.

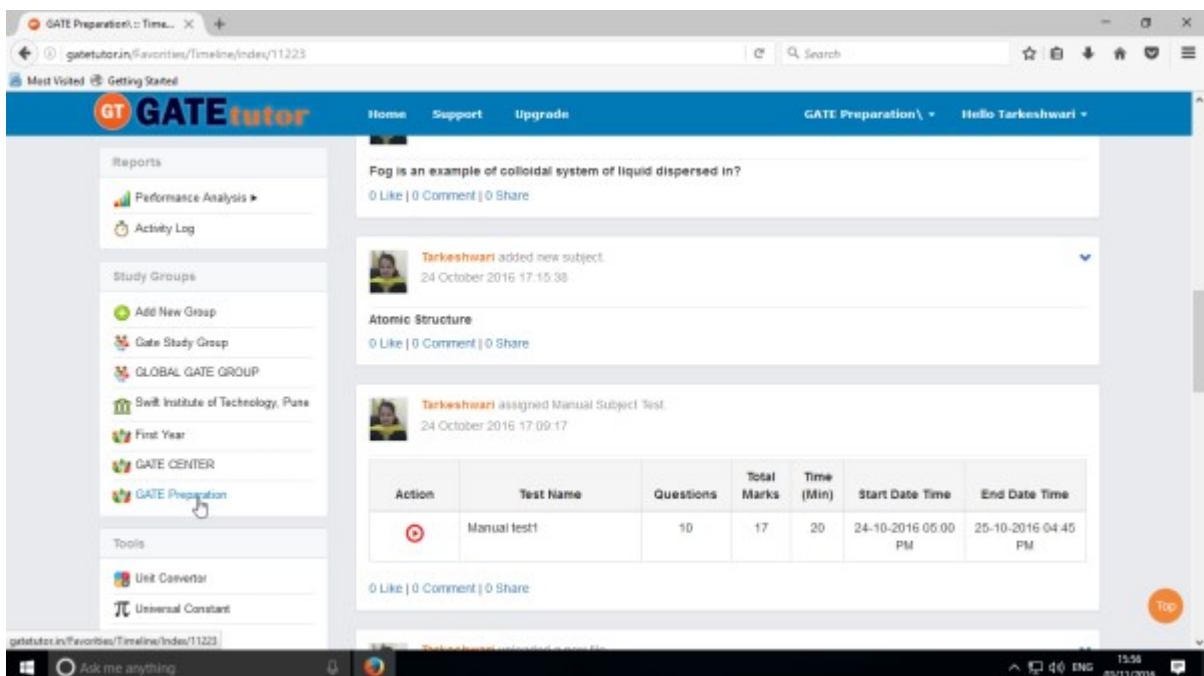


Click on **“OK”** to continue.

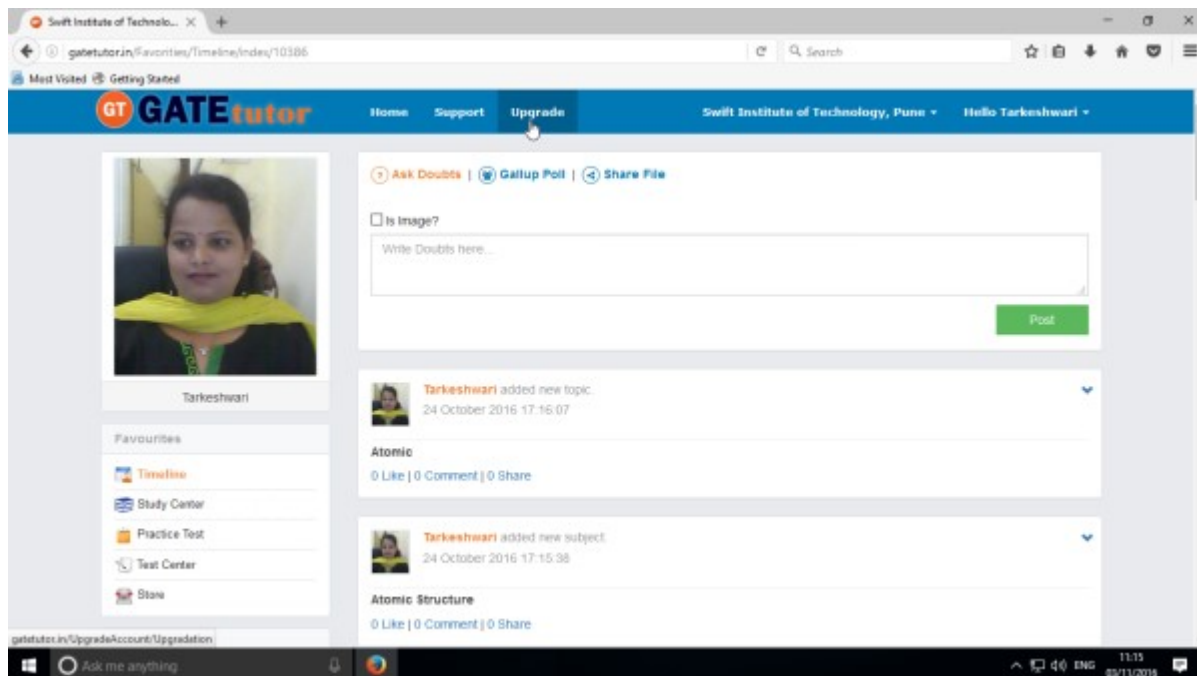


You can also check that the new global group is created in the “**Study Groups**”

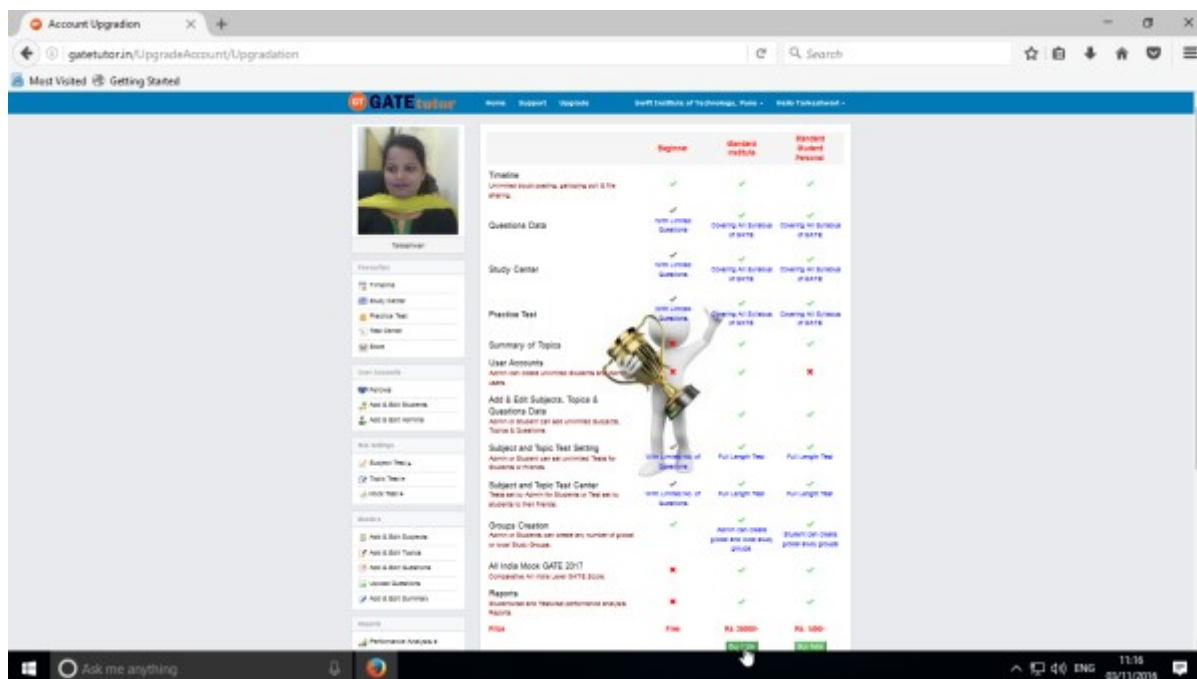
Click on “**College Name**” to go back to your college timeline.

When you register as a College Student at first time, it is a free beginner version. Here you can access the features of GATetutor like practice tests, subject & topic test. But it has a limited access.

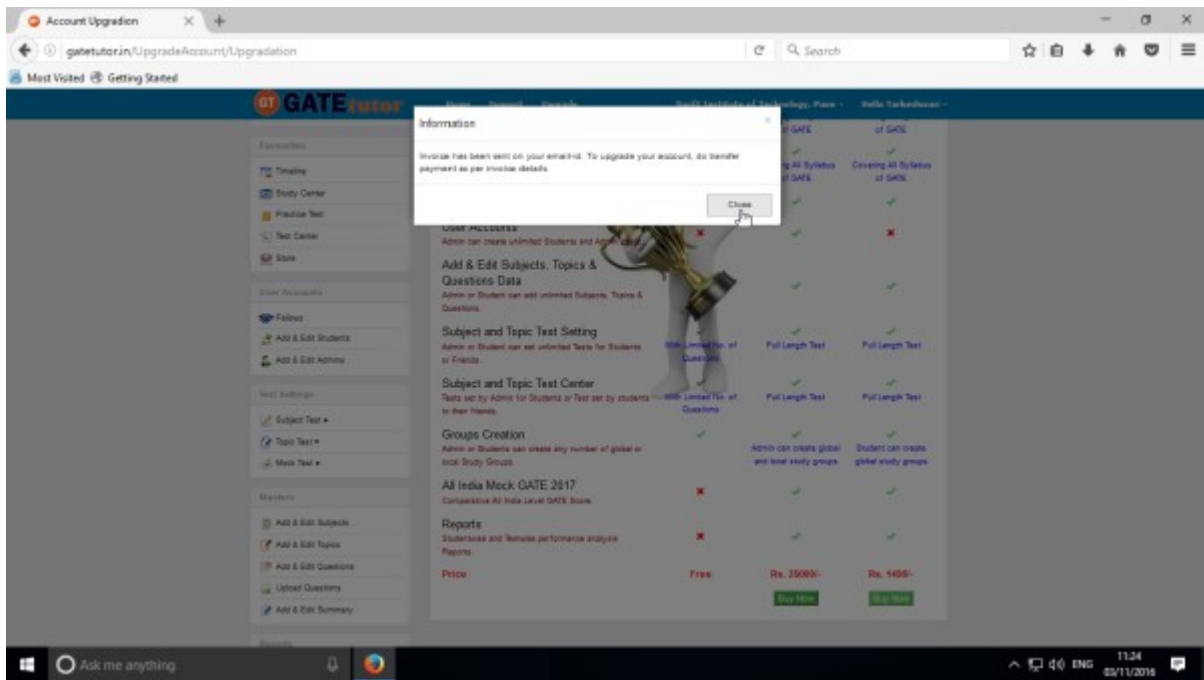


When you upgrade your account to the “**Standard**” version, you will get the full access of all GATetutor features. Click on “**Upgrade**” to get standard version

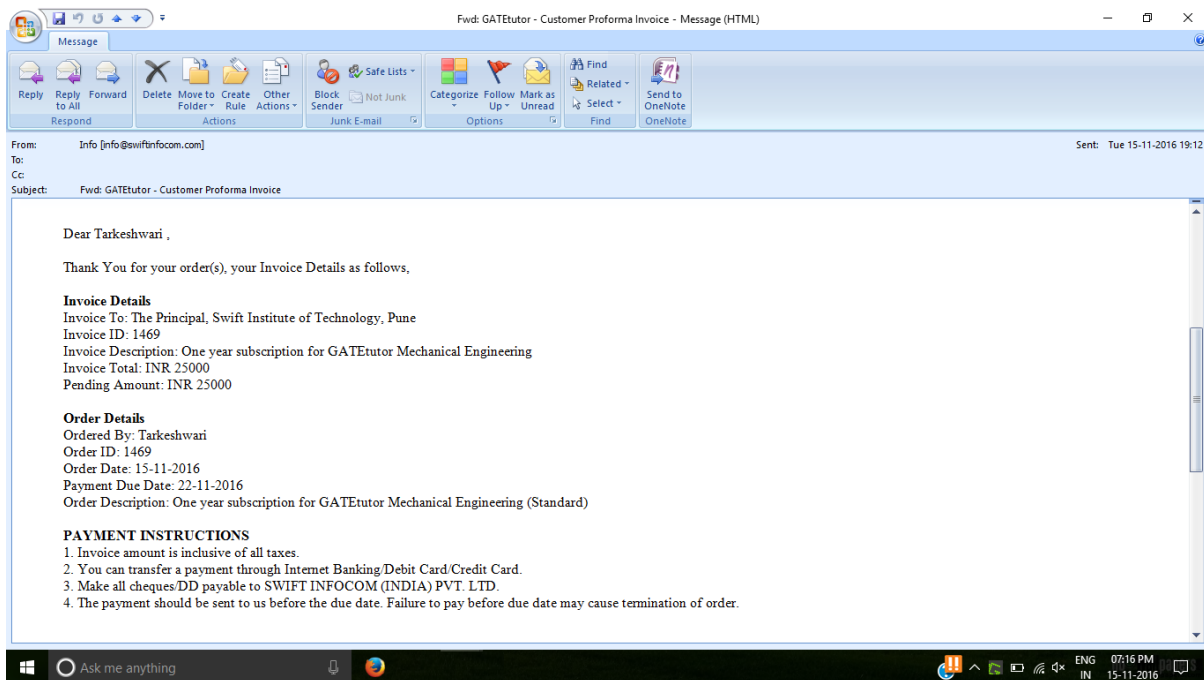


Check the above image to compare the features between “**Beginner**” & “**Standard**” version

III. Favourites (On College Timeline)

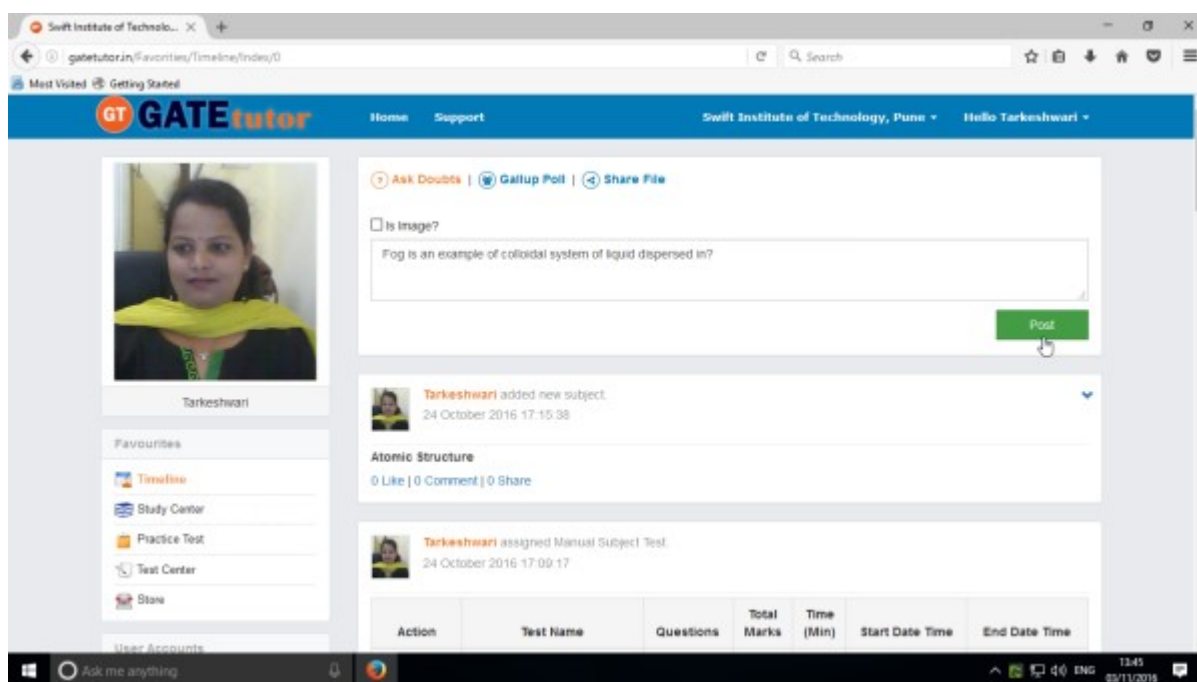
1. Timeline

A schedule of all activities or events performed by all the fellows in the college group that will occur on Timeline with time frame when you click on the “**Timeline**”

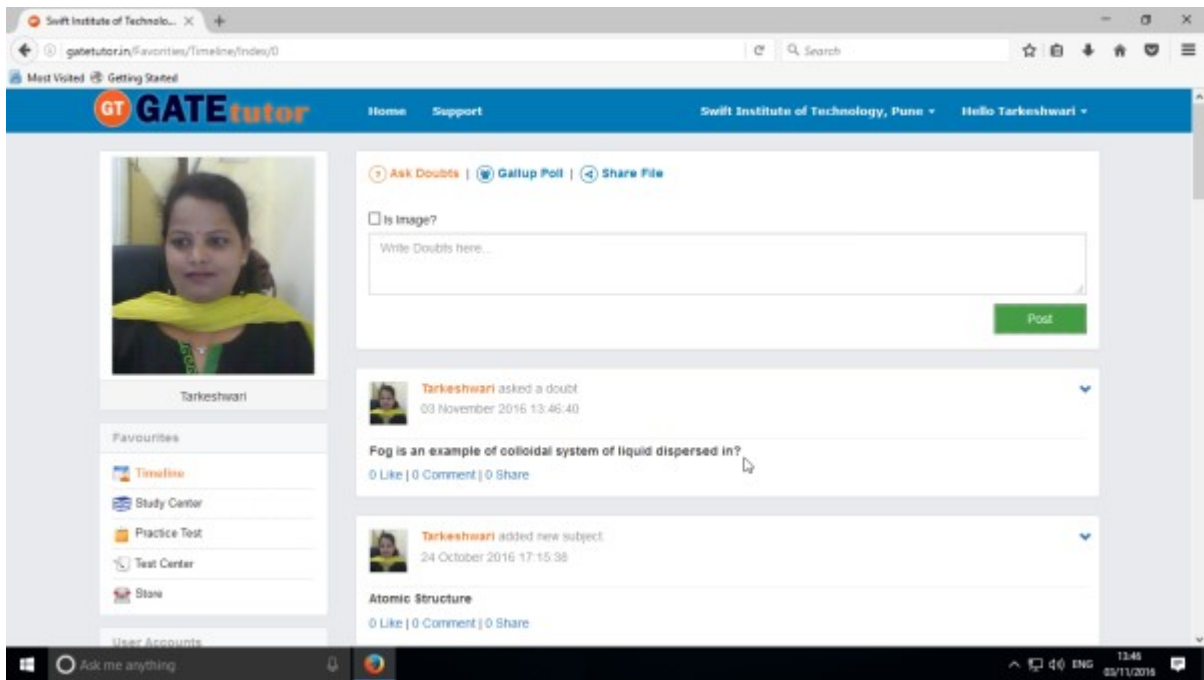
a) Ask Doubt

Ask doubt to your friends by clicking on “**Ask Doubt**”

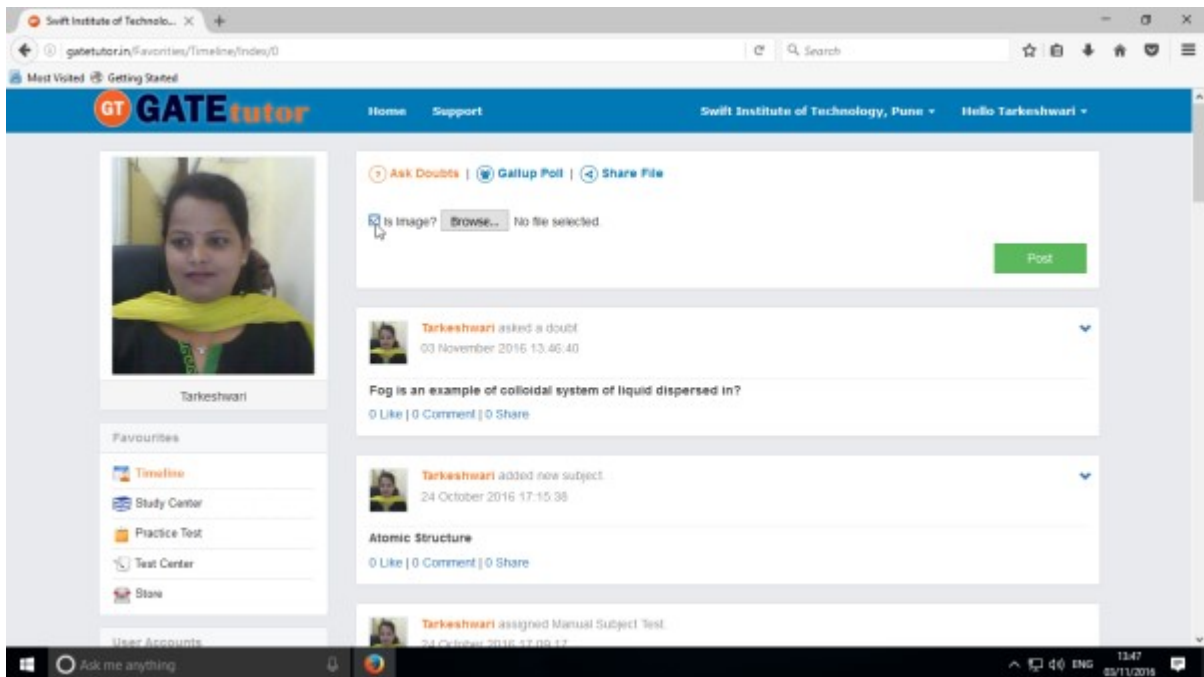


Write your doubt & click on the “**Post**” as above

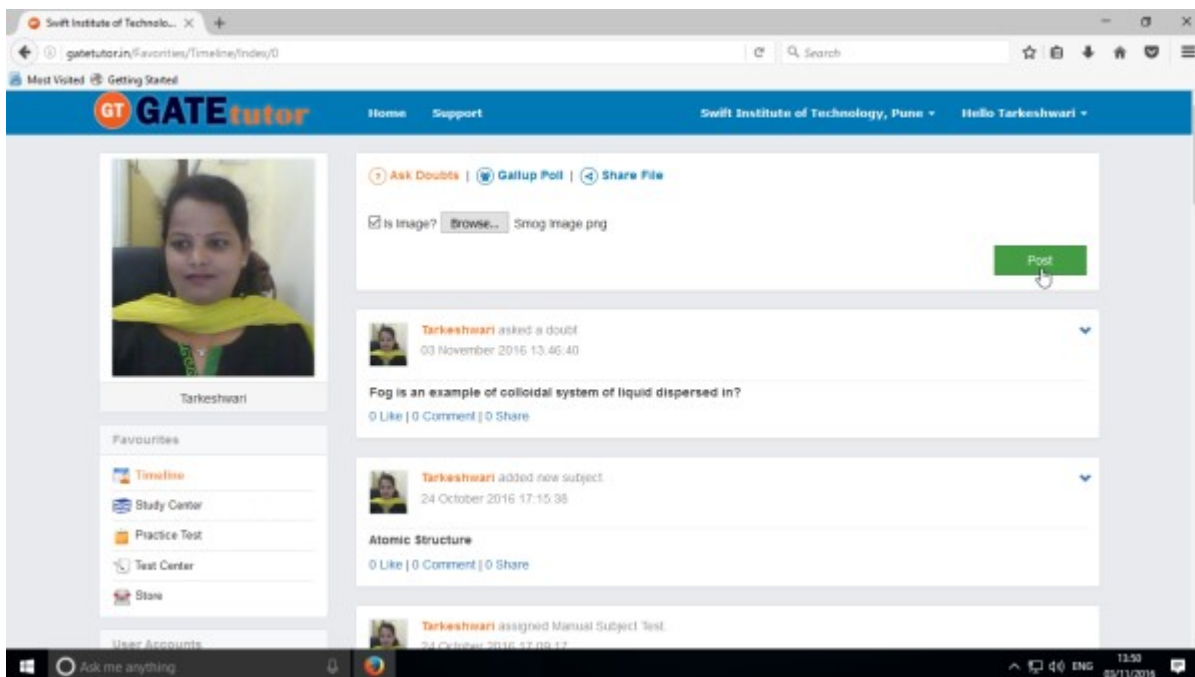


Your doubt will be visible on the college timeline. You can see a doubt.

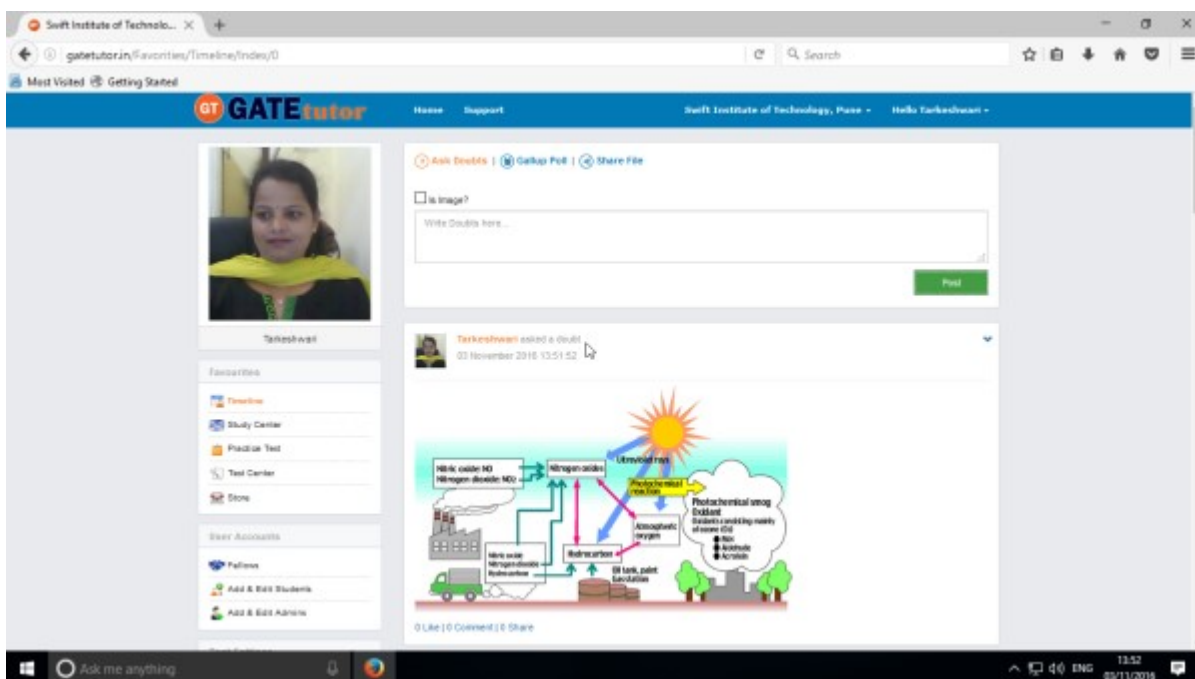
You can upload an image also by clicking on the “**Is image?**” check box to post in “Ask Doubts”



Click on the “**Is Image?**” and then click on “**Browse**” to upload the file for asking a doubt. Choose the file to upload & click on the “**Post**”

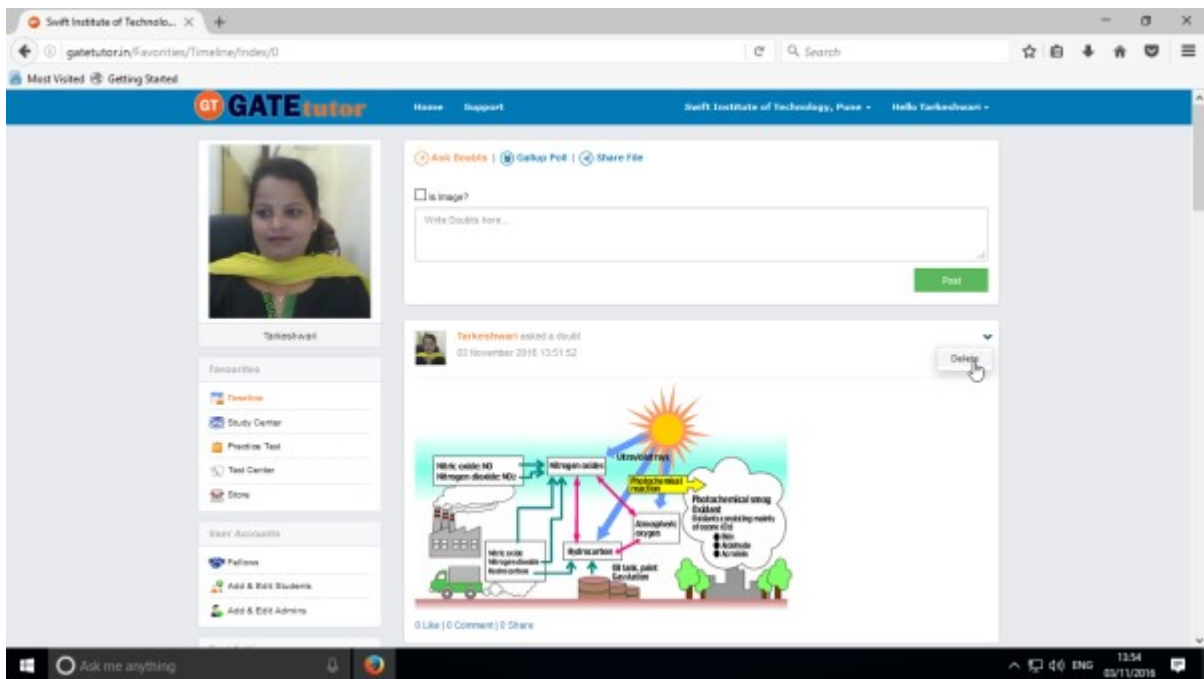


When you click on the “Post” after choosing an image, it will post on your college timeline.

Click on “Delete” to remove the image from “Ask Doubt” menu.

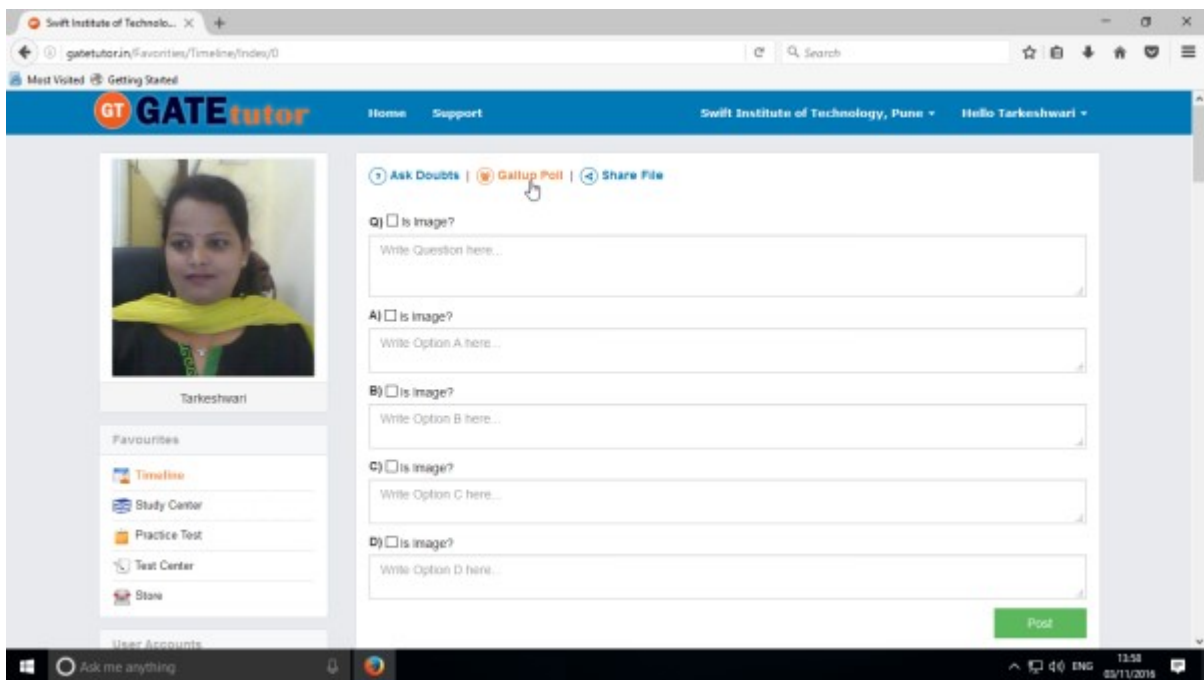
When you click on “Delete”, the uploaded image will be deleted from “Ask Doubt” on college timeline.

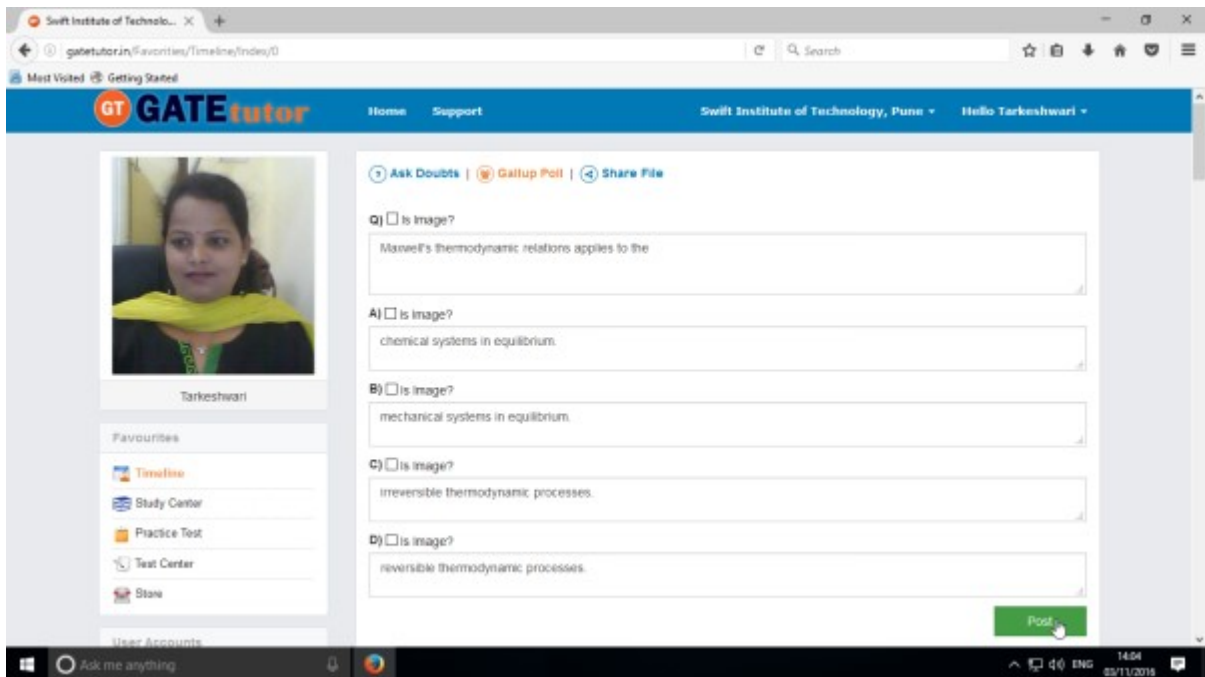
You can also upload an image for the question and options separately.

Click on a “Gallup Poll”

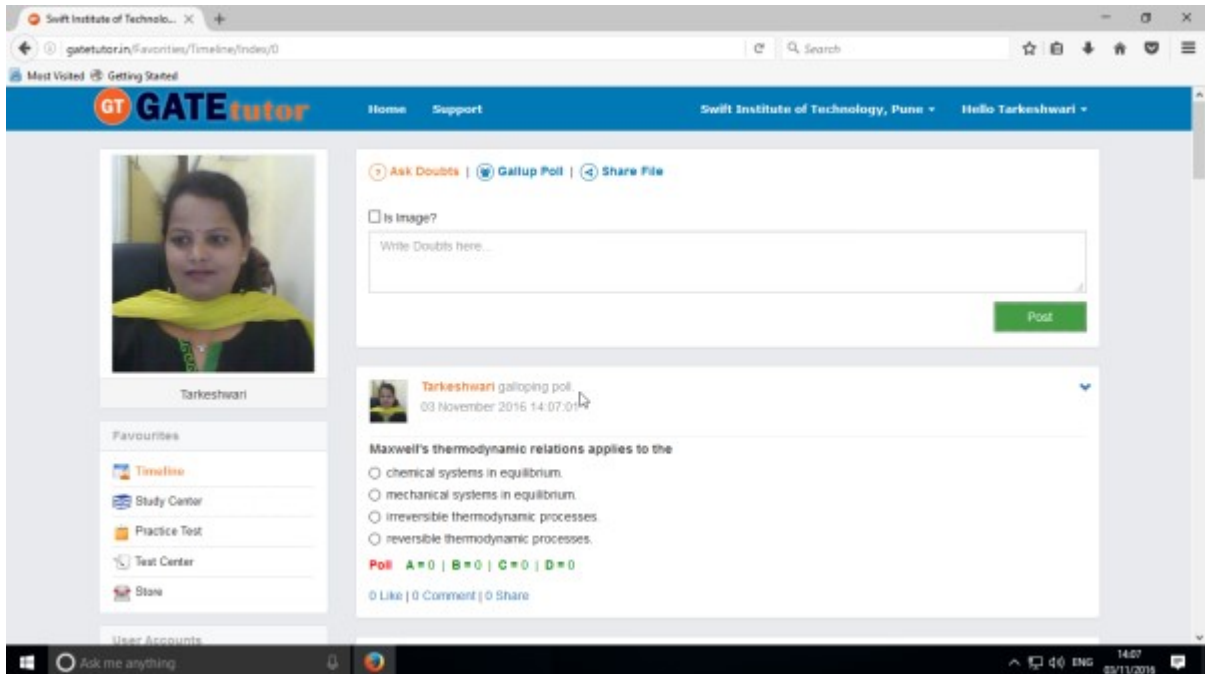

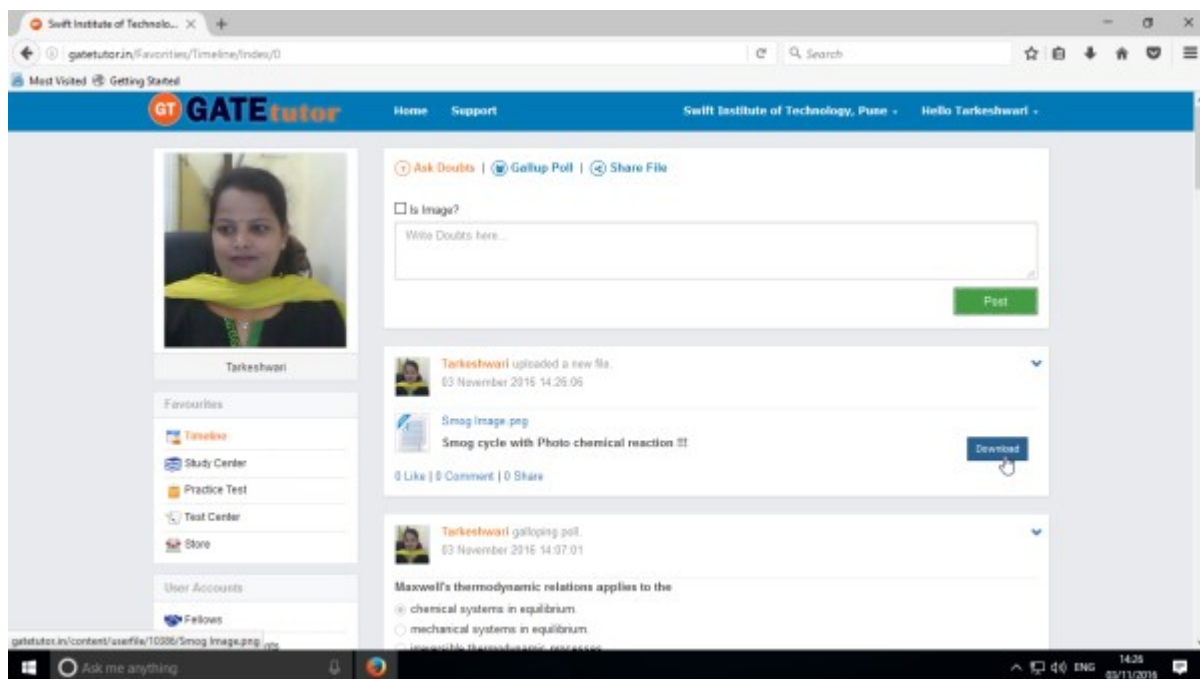
Similarly you can like, comment and share the question on your friend's timeline as well as in any group. Your fellows can share this question as post in various other groups and timeline.

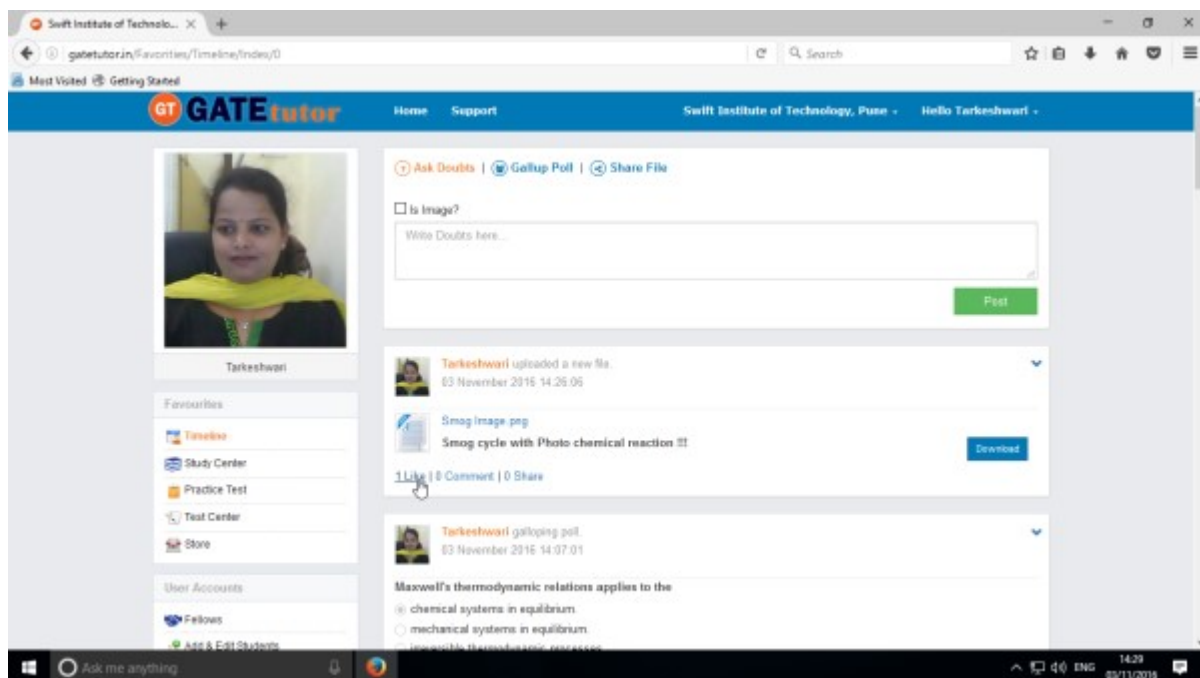
When you click on **“Post”**, the post will be shared on your college timeline. You can also share audio, video, word, pdf, image formats, excel file and various file formats.



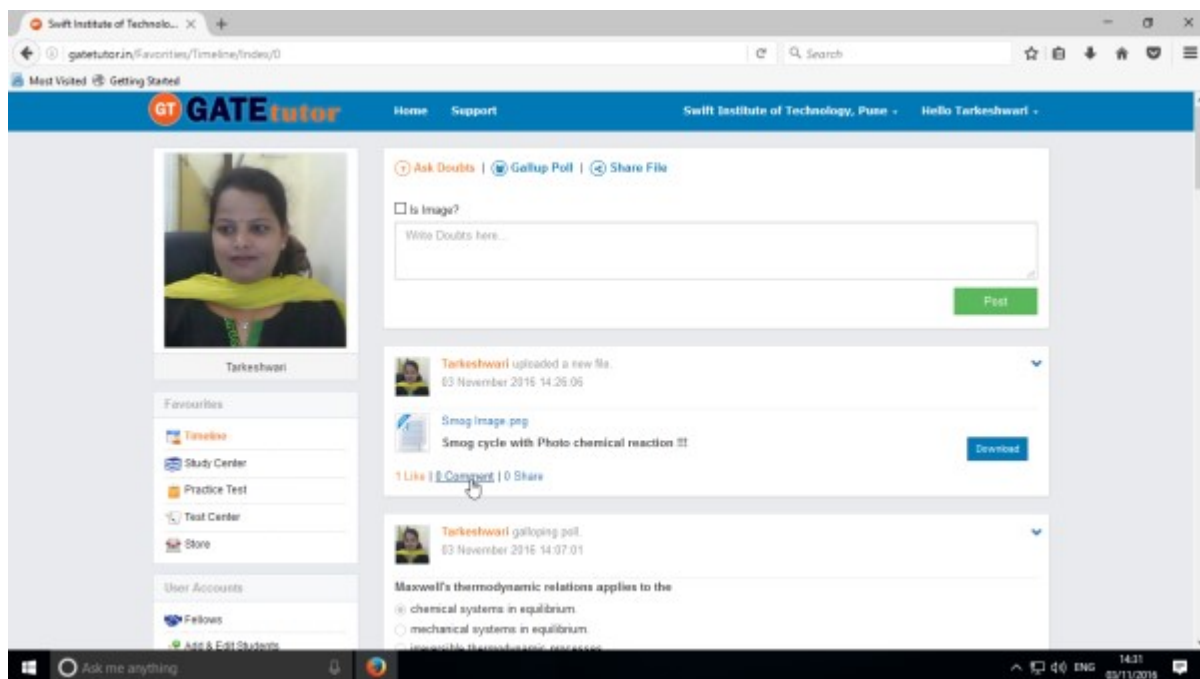
If you want to download the study material just click on **“Download”** option & the file will get downloaded to use. You can download this file from Store also.

You and your fellows can like the post on your college timeline by clicking on “Like” which will be shared by your fellow or admin faculty member or by you own.

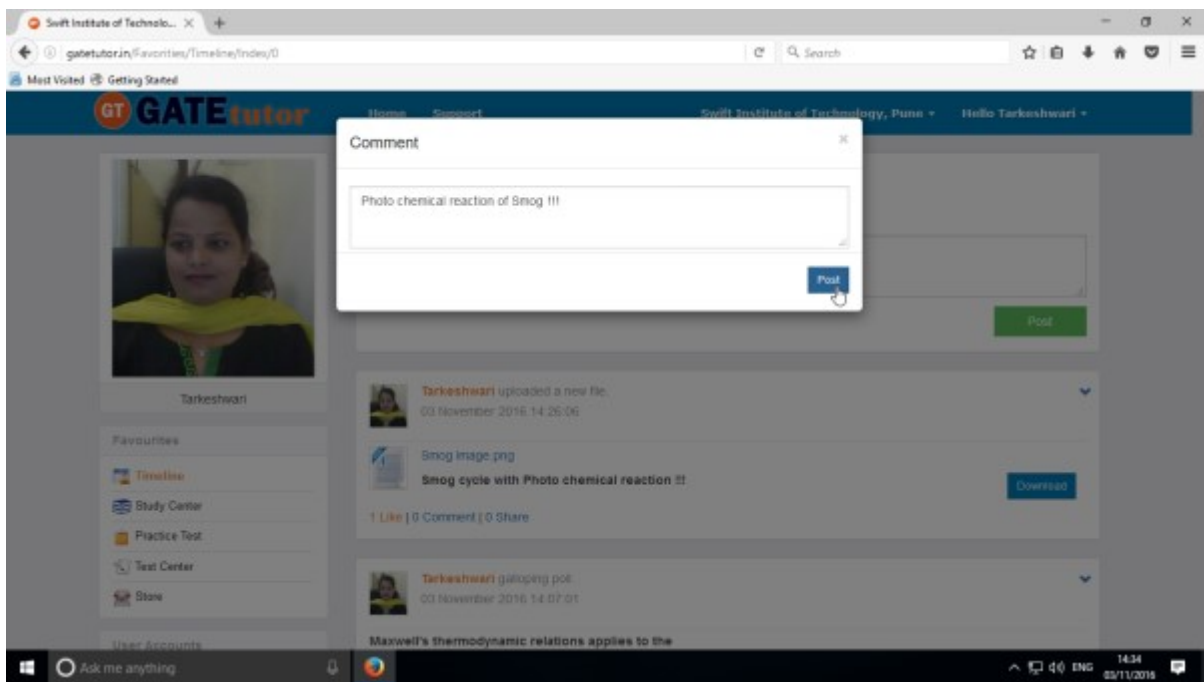


You can comment on any post & that comment will post on college timeline.



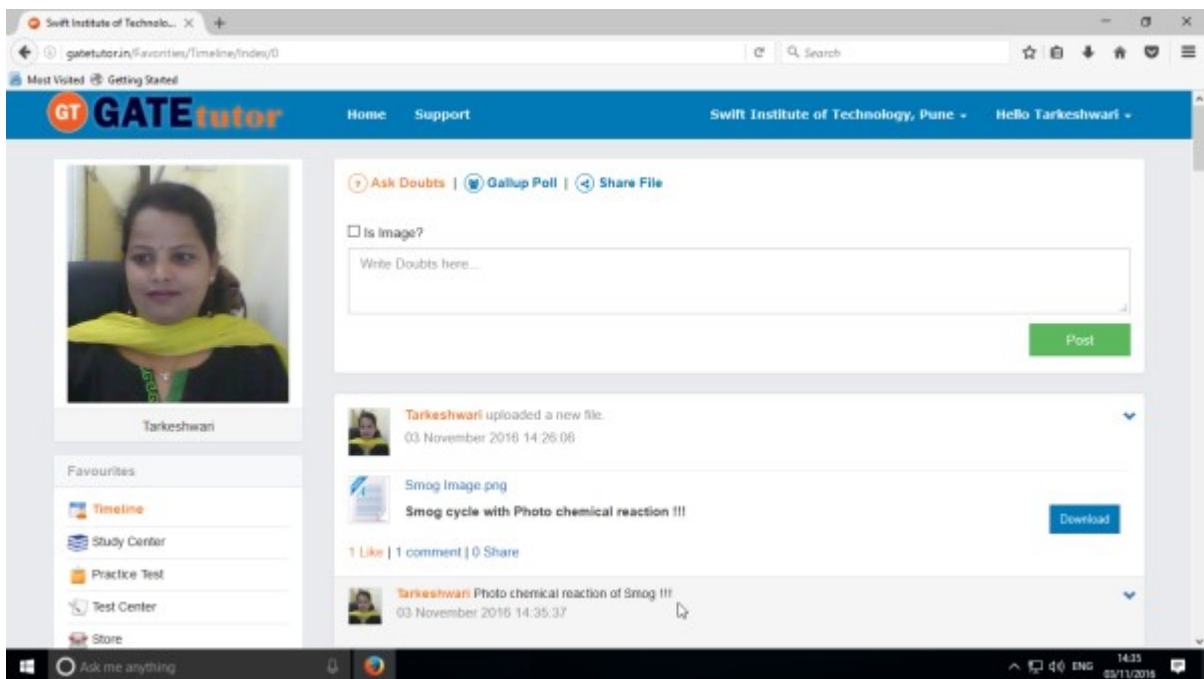
e) Post a Comment

You can comment on post by clicking on “Comment”

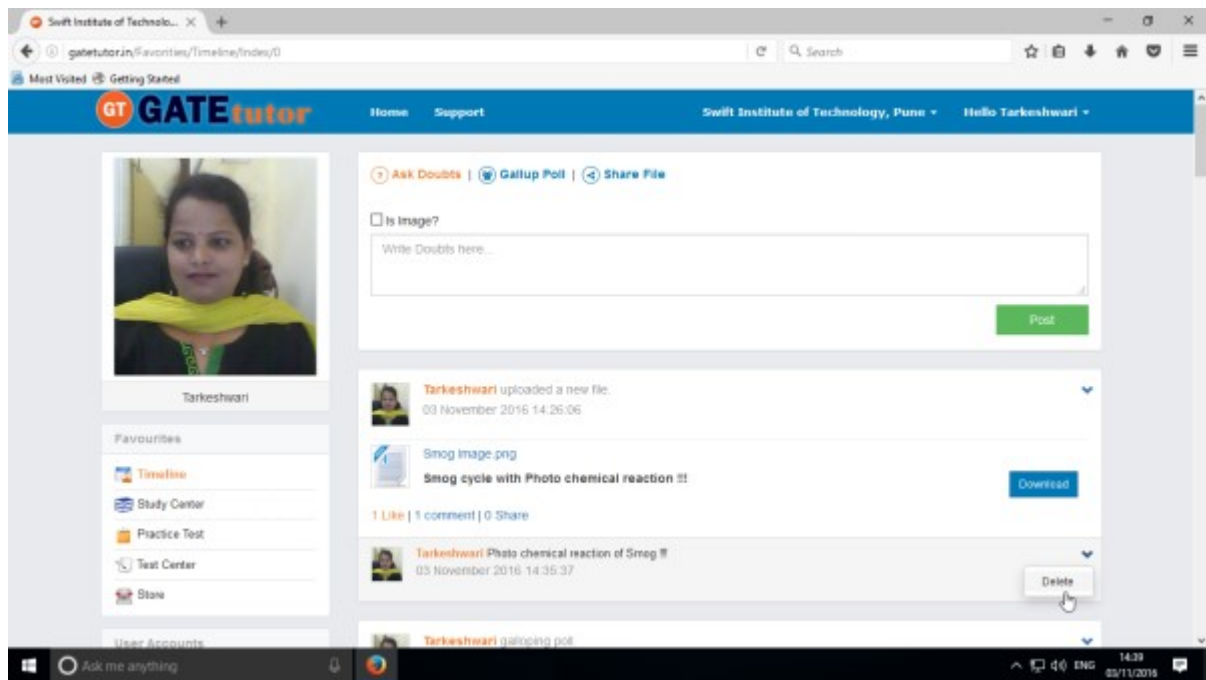


Enter the comment in the comment box & click on “Post” as above

When you click on “Post”, your comment will be shared & displayed on college timeline

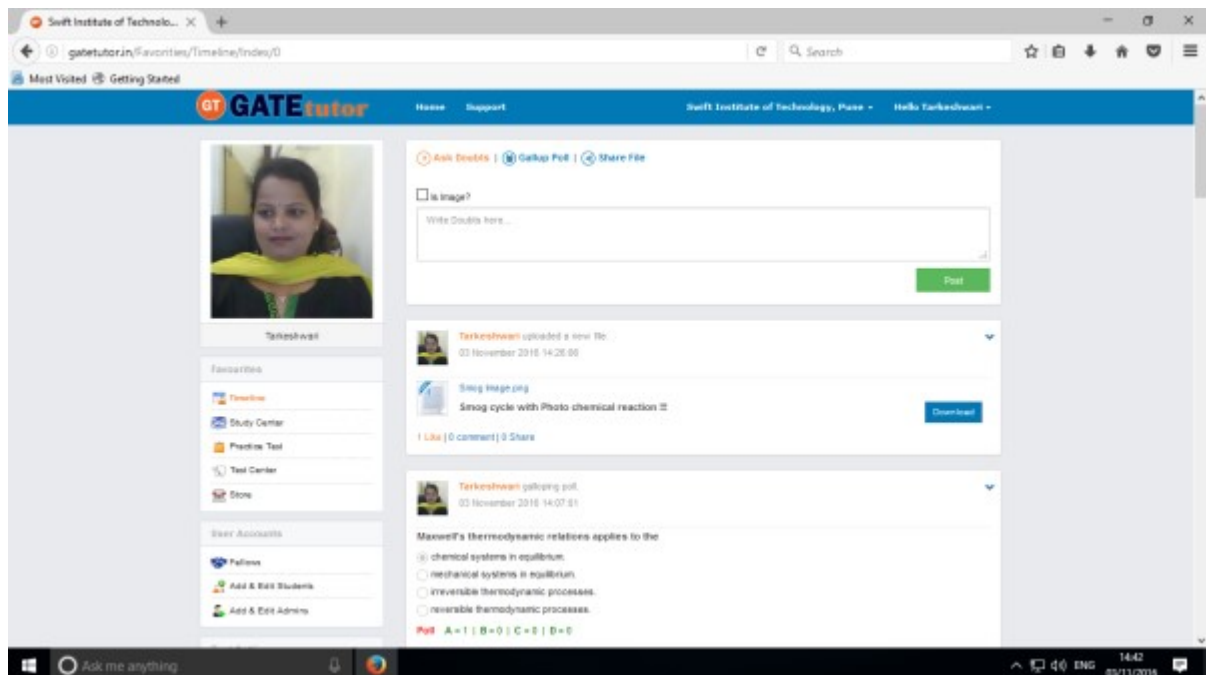


f) Delete a Comment



Only the person can delete the comment who has commented on the post. Click on “Delete” button, the comment will be deleted from the post.

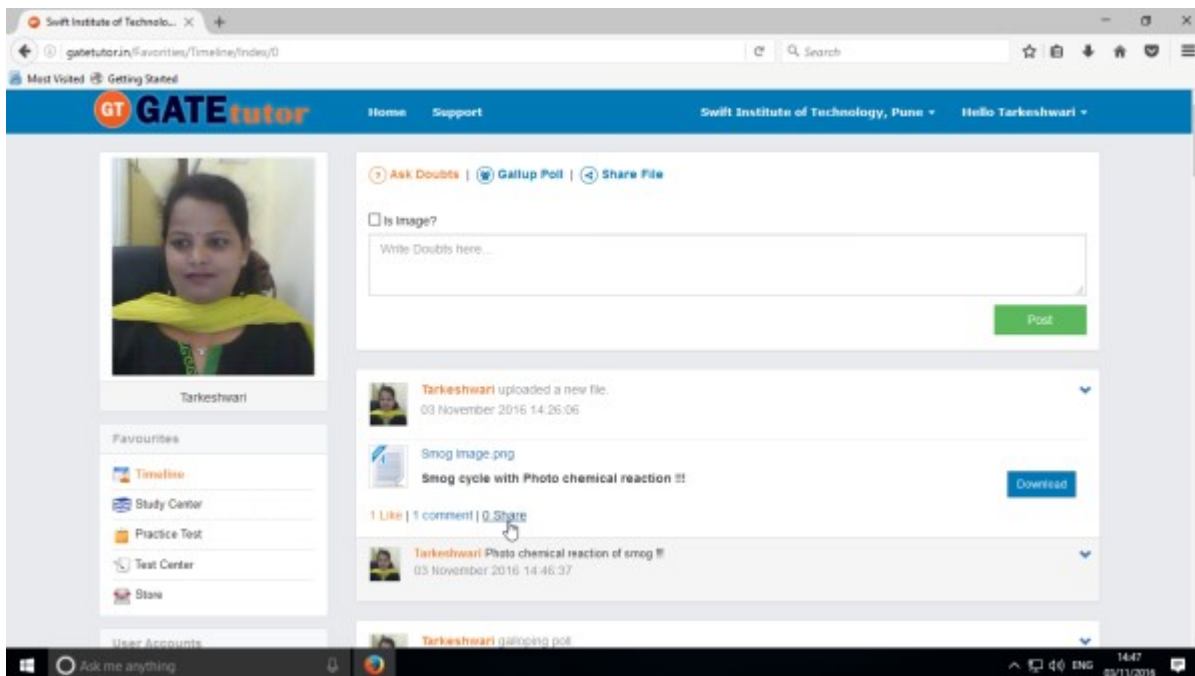

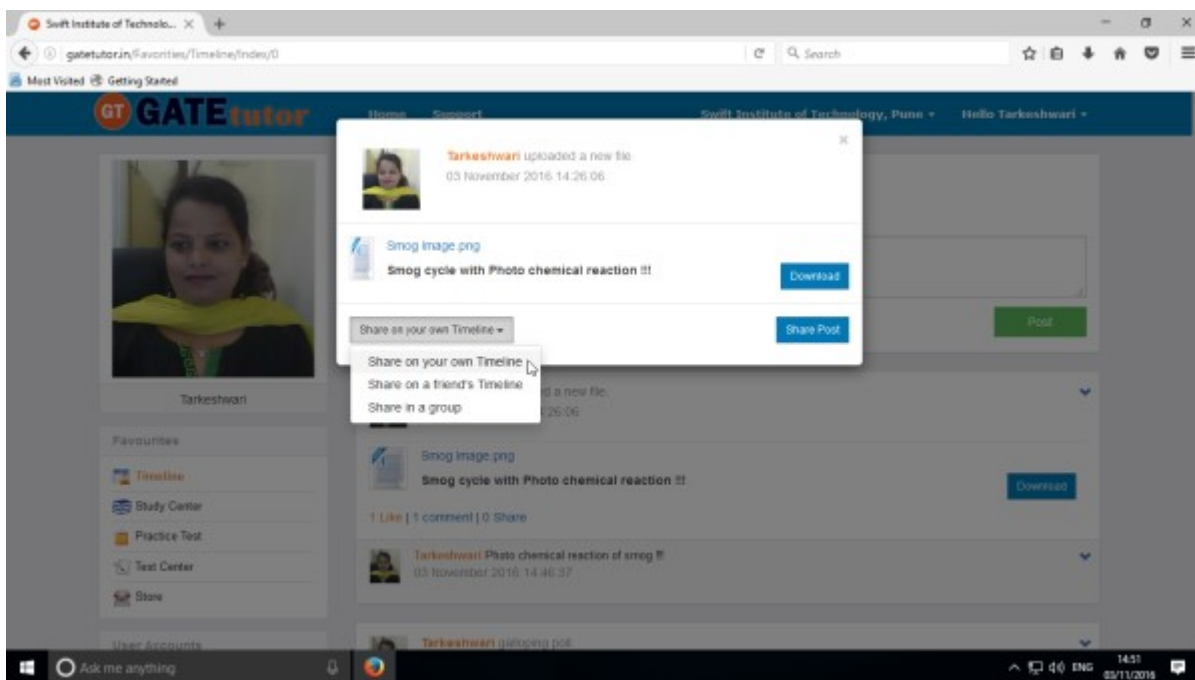
g) Share Post

You can share the post on your own Timeline, friend's timeline & in the group in which you are the member.

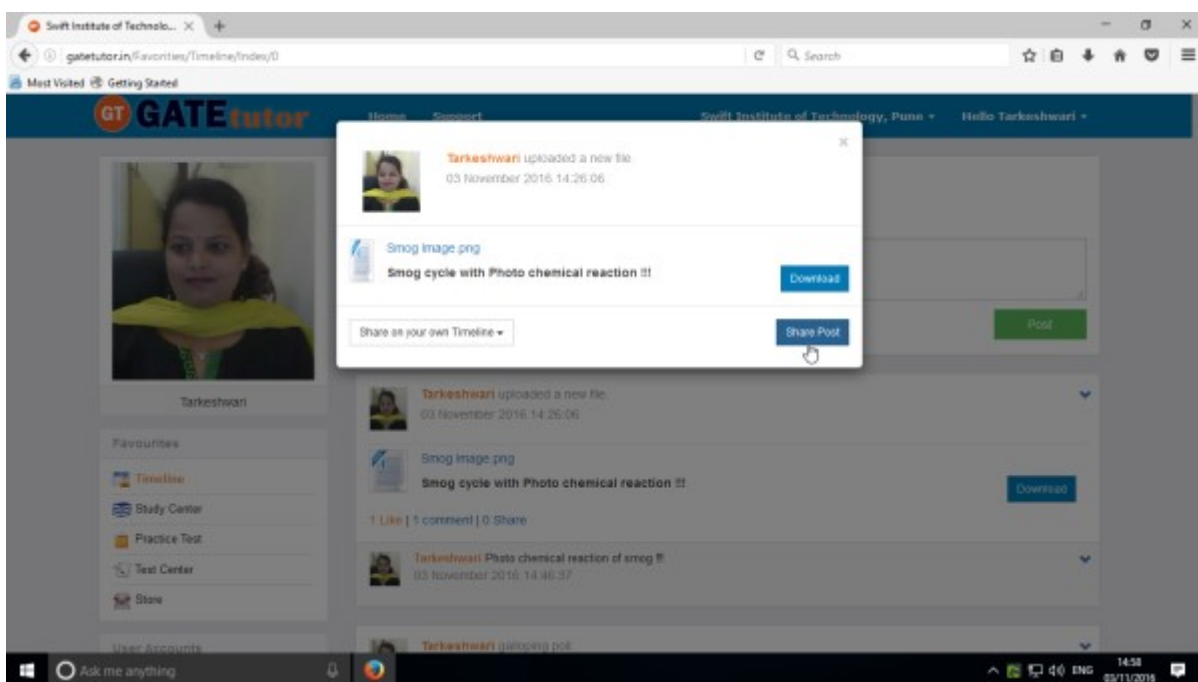
To share the post click on **"Share"**

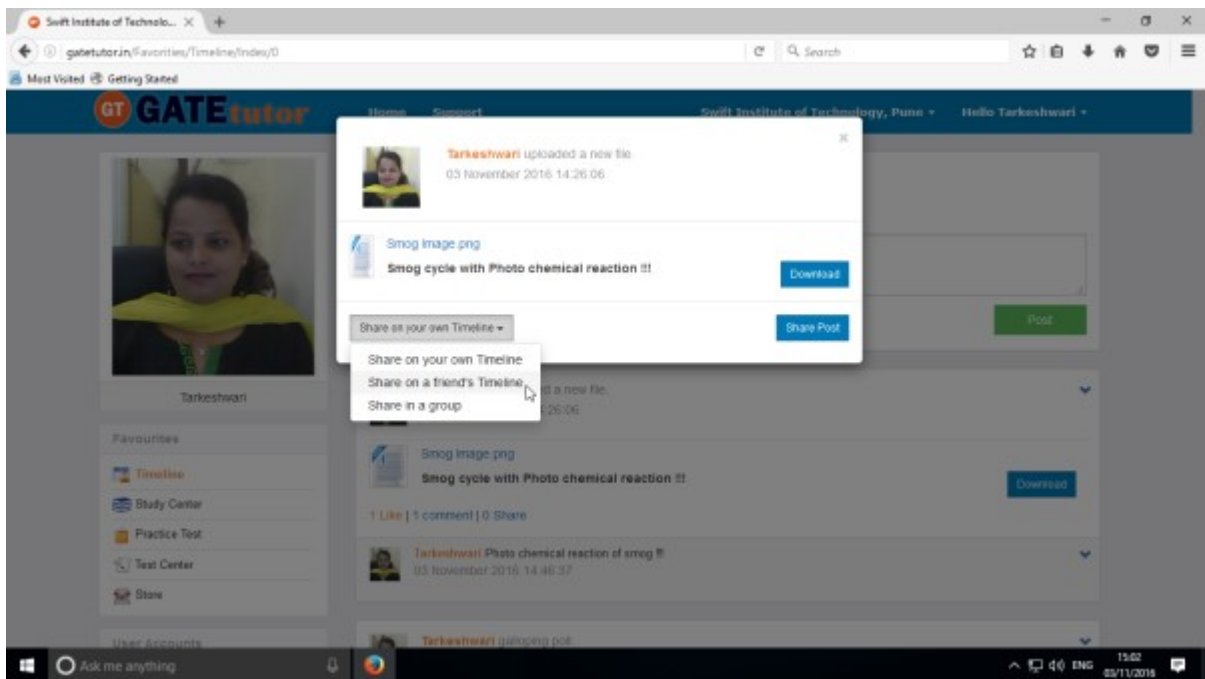

Post will get shared on your own timeline

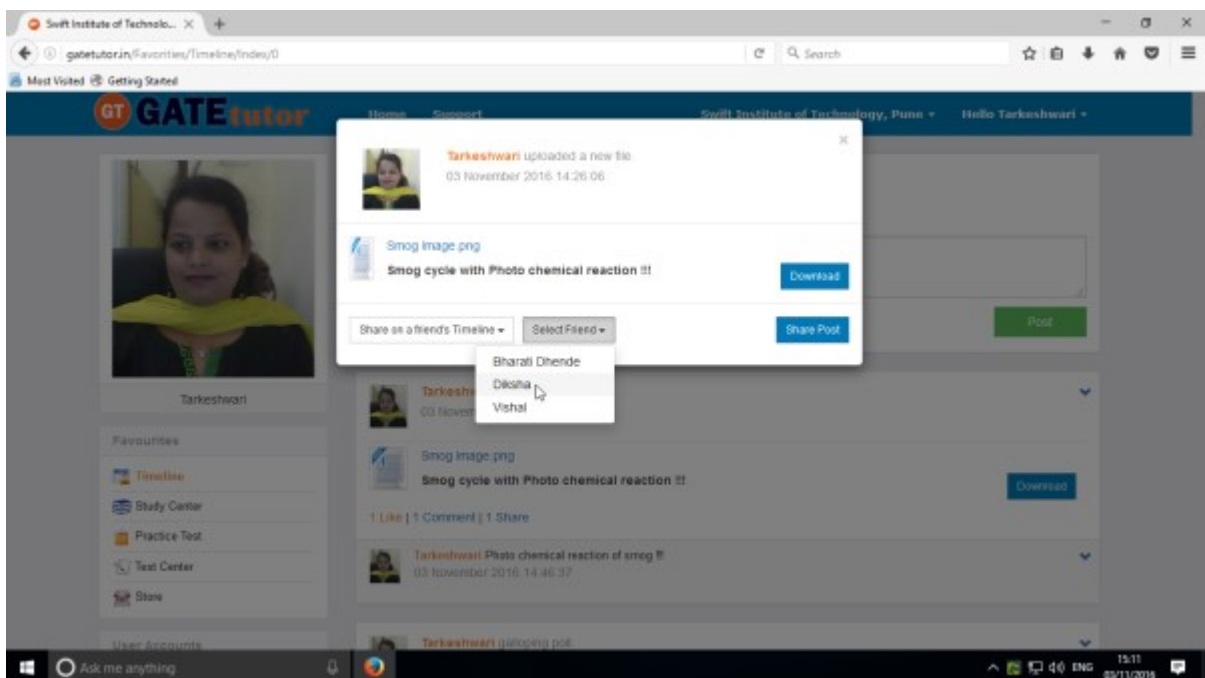
Go to your own timeline to check the shared post.

Now, select an option to choose where you want to share the post.



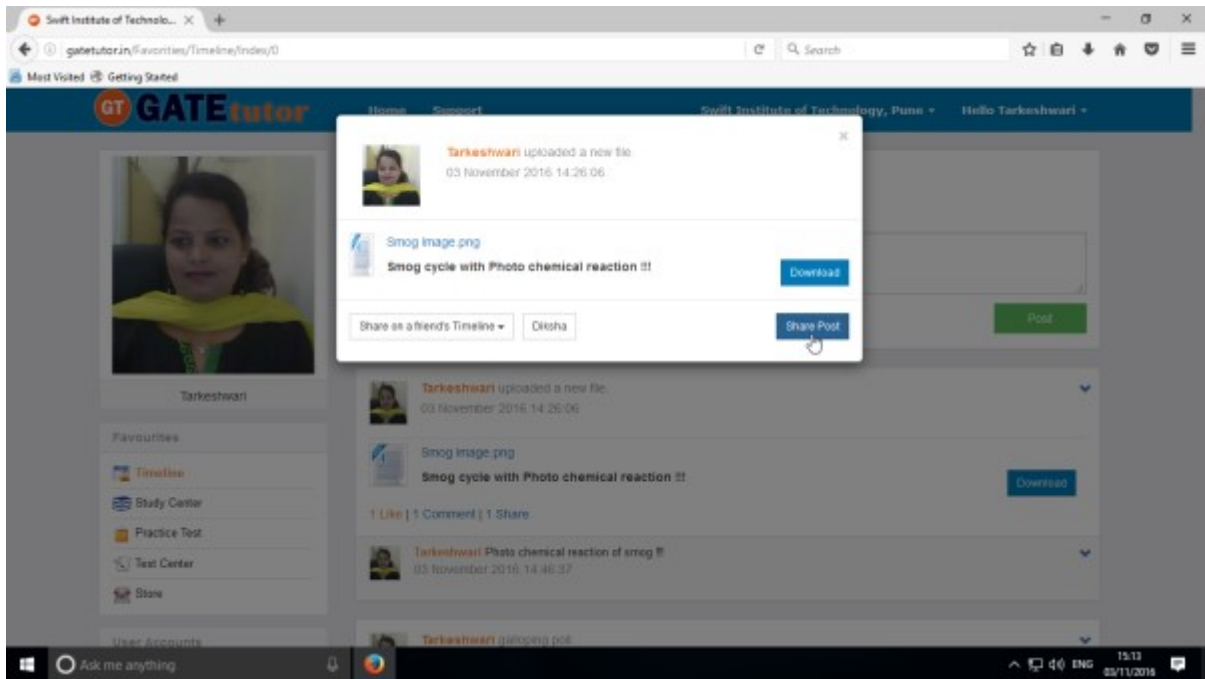

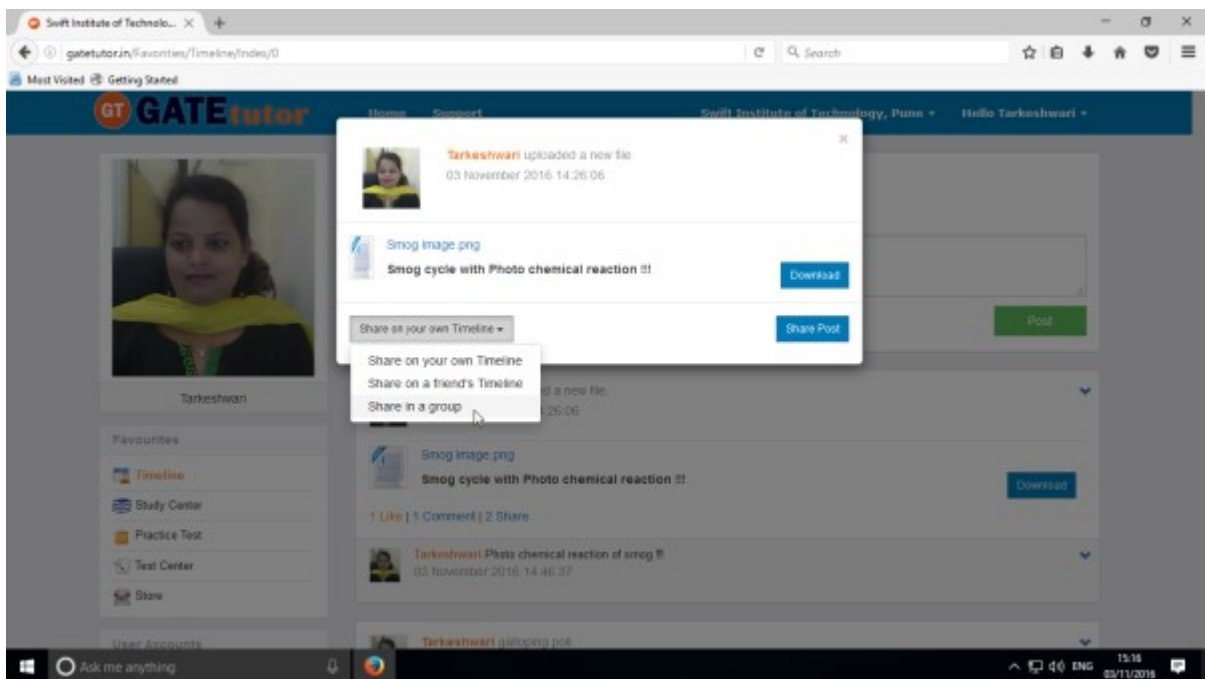
When you select a friend name to post on his/her name, click on friend name shown as above

After choosing both of options click on the “Share Post”

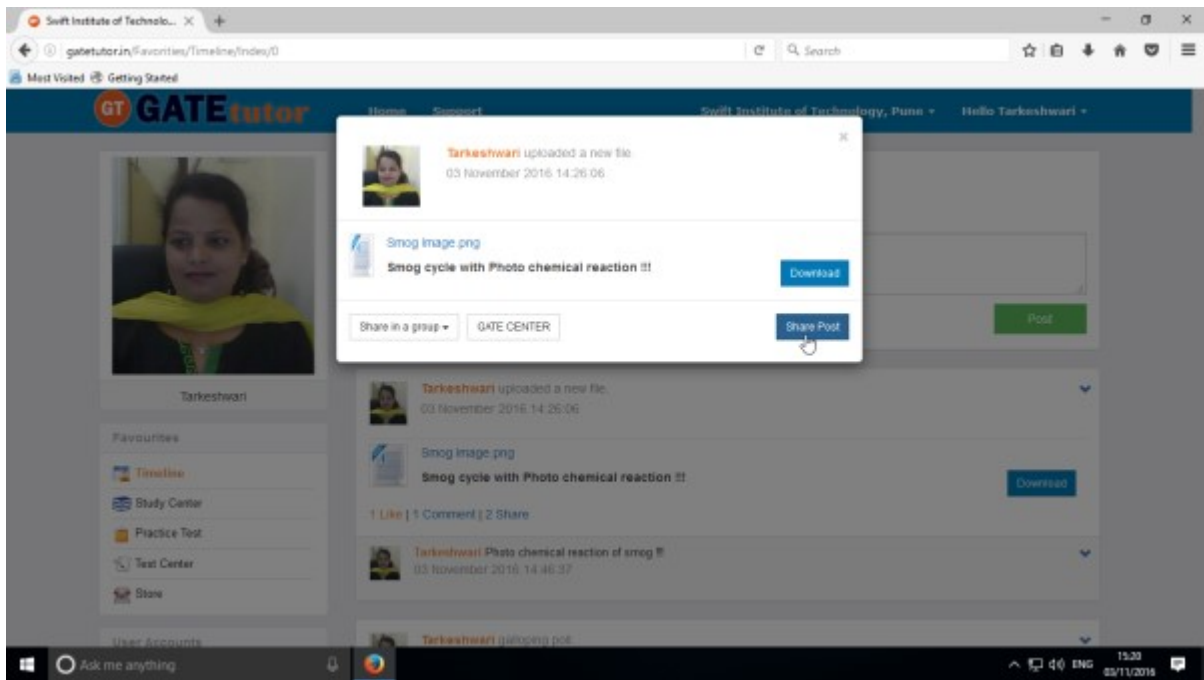

You can share the post in the group in which you are the member or in the group which is created by you



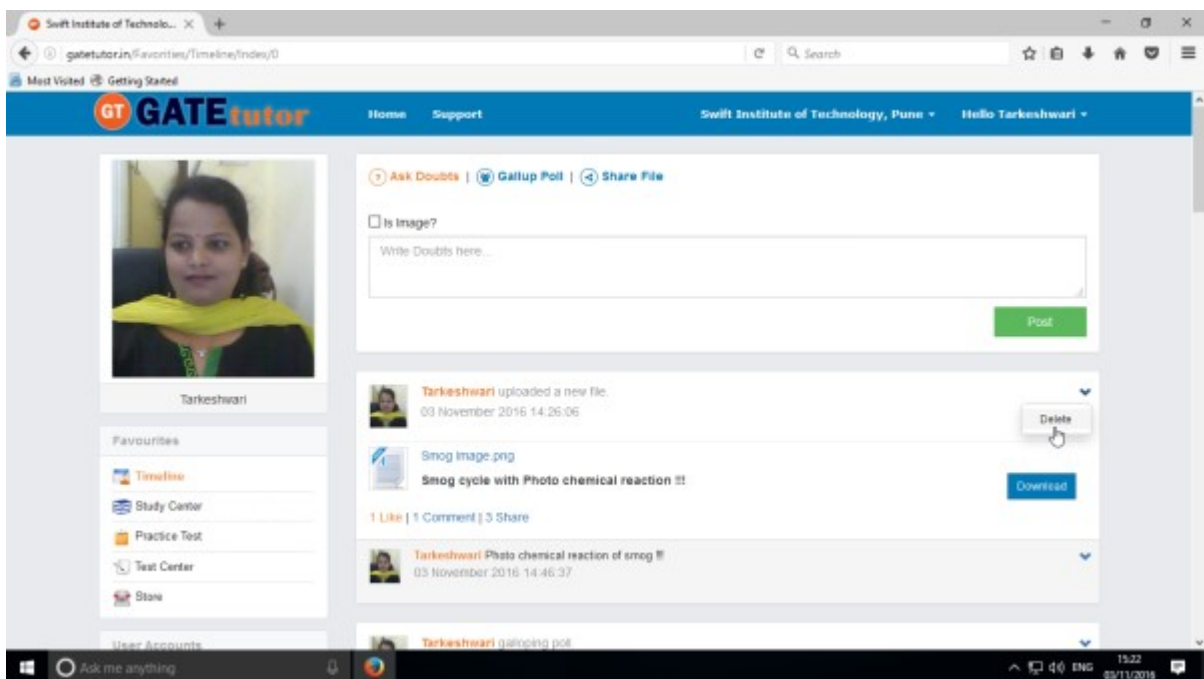
Click on the “Share in a group” & choose the group name to share the post



After choosing the both sharing options, click on the **“Share Post”** & go to the group’s timeline to check the post that you have shared.

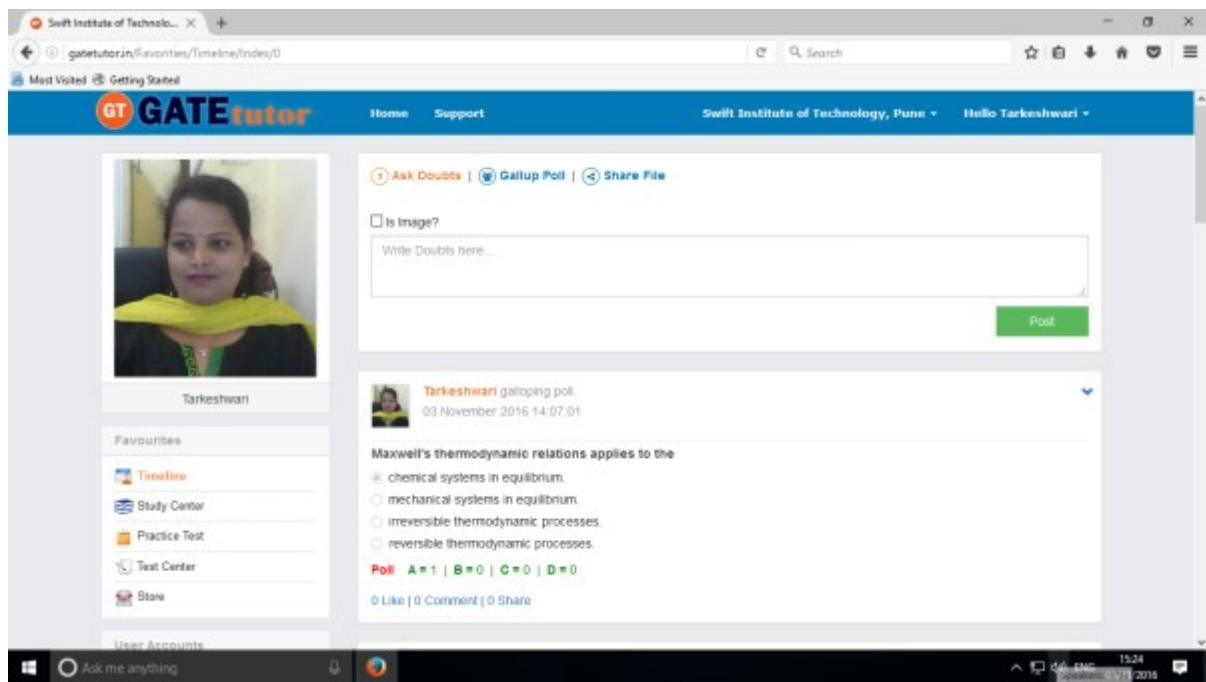
h) Delete Post

2) Study Center

a) General Info

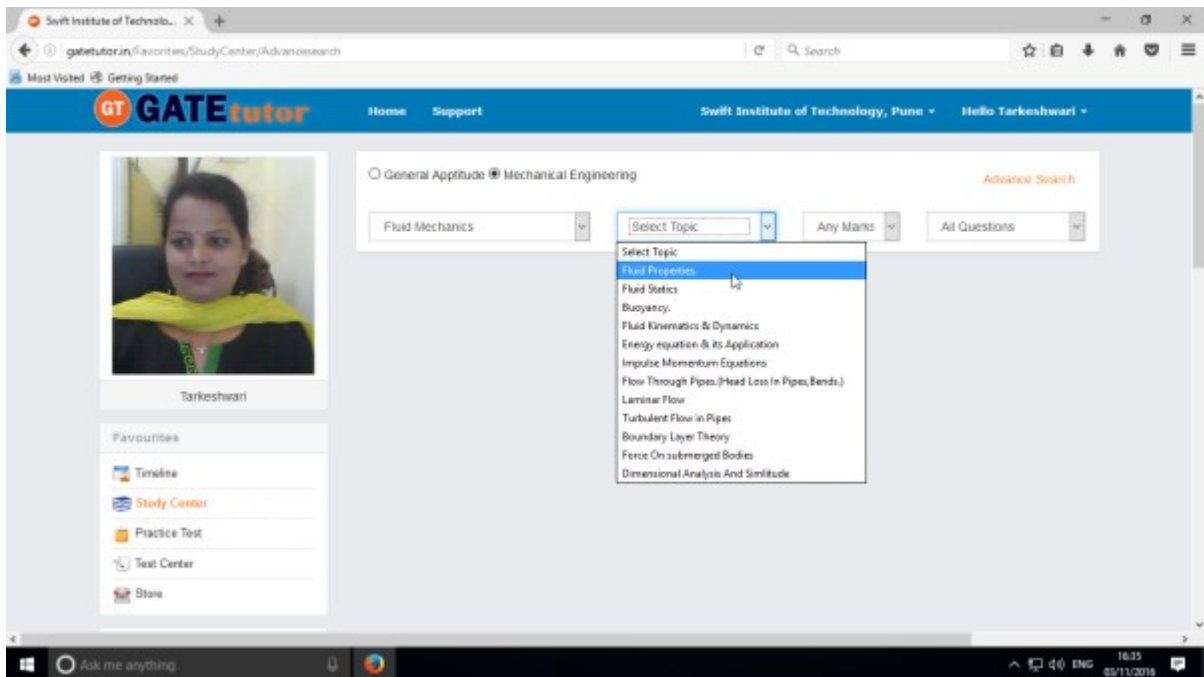
It is a unique studying method provided by the GATetutor.

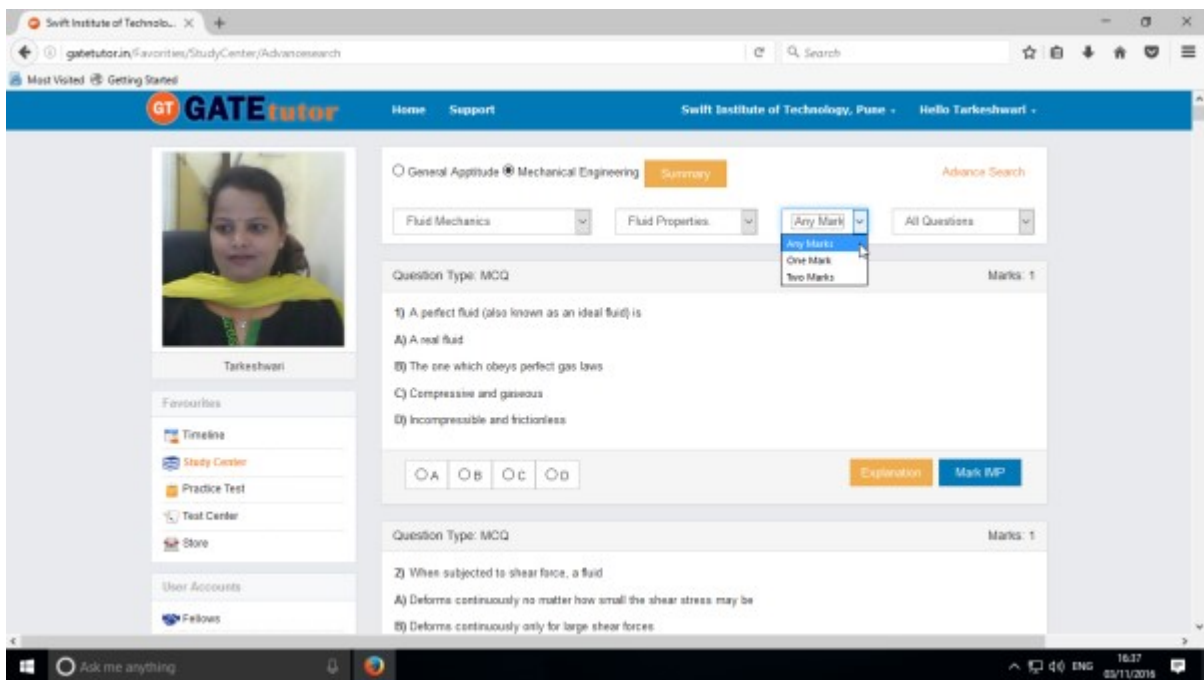

Choose from main menu General Aptitude or Chemical Engineering stream.

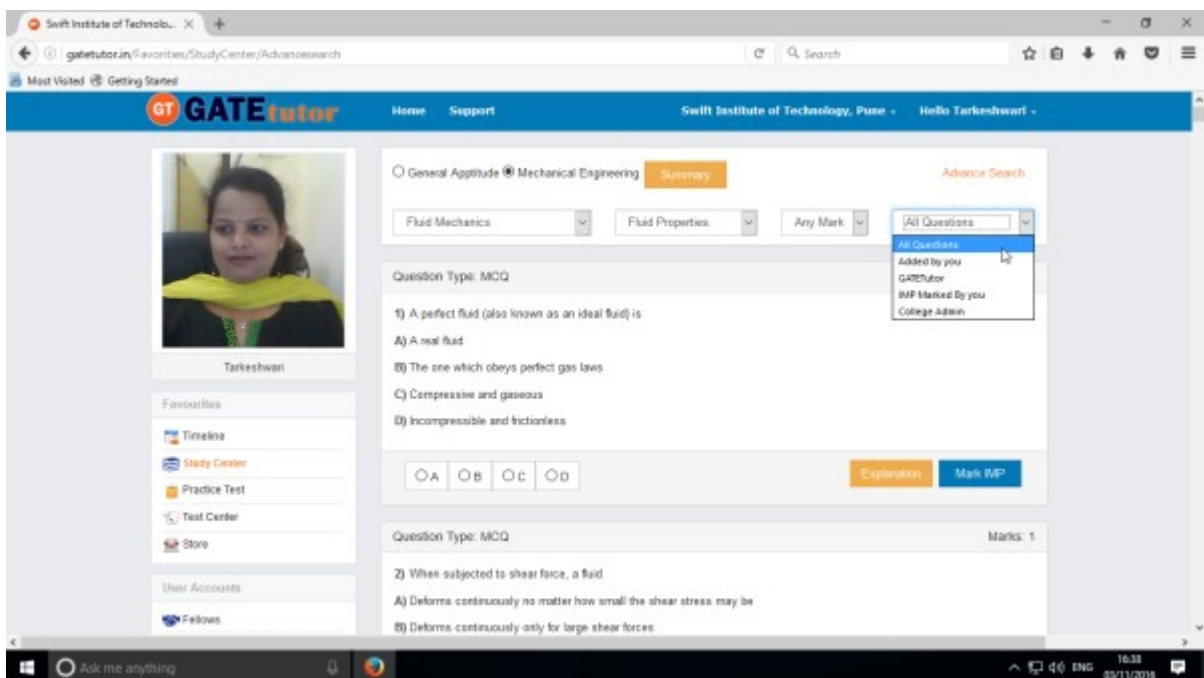
Select subject & Topic



Select “Any marks” for questions with 1 mark or 2 marks.



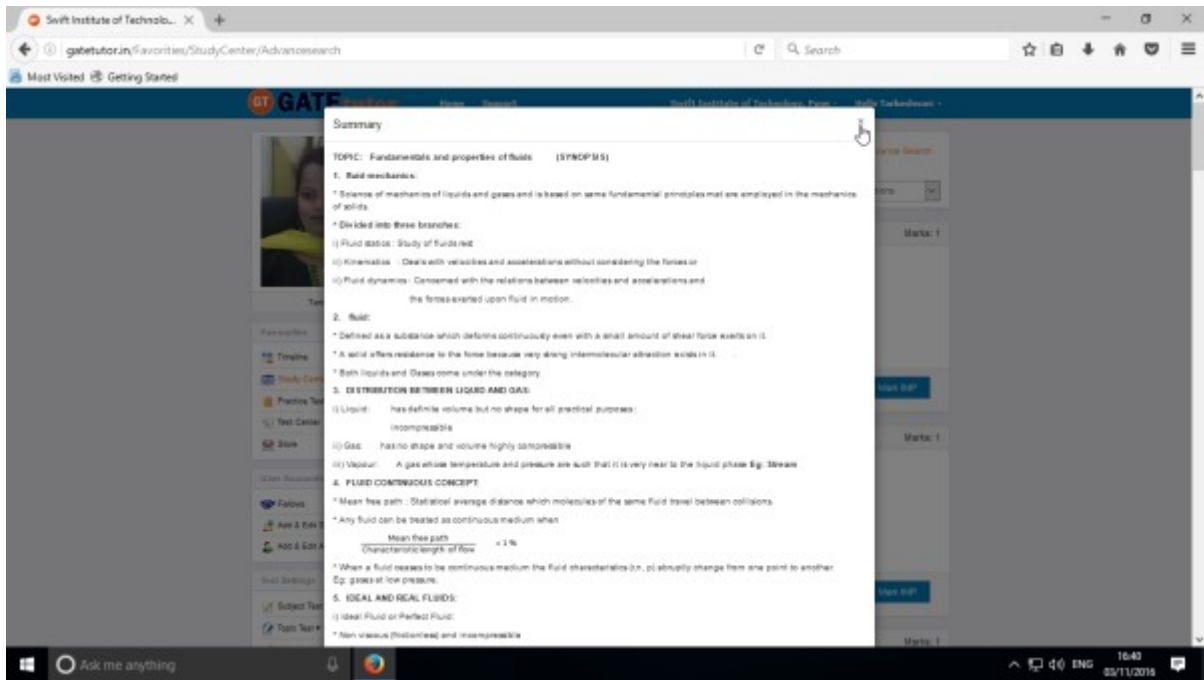
Choose “All Questions” to study more questions. You can also choose the questions from Added by you, GATetutor, IMP Marked By you and College Admin.



Choose questions from the different types of sources as above.

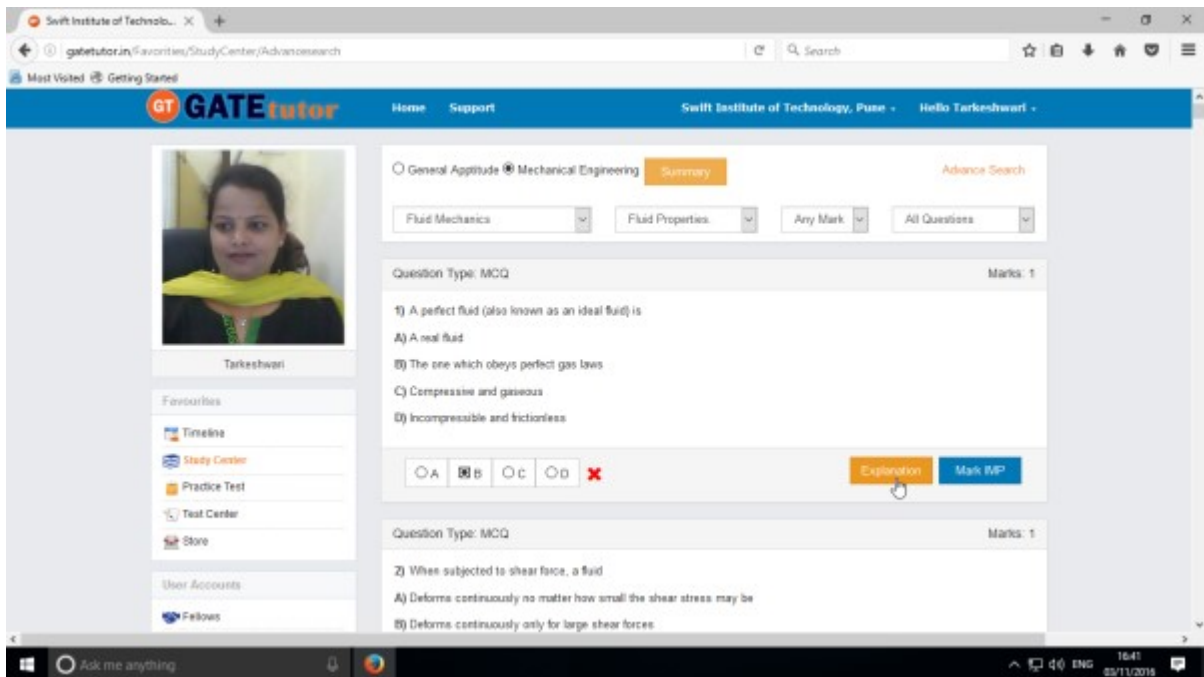
b) Summary

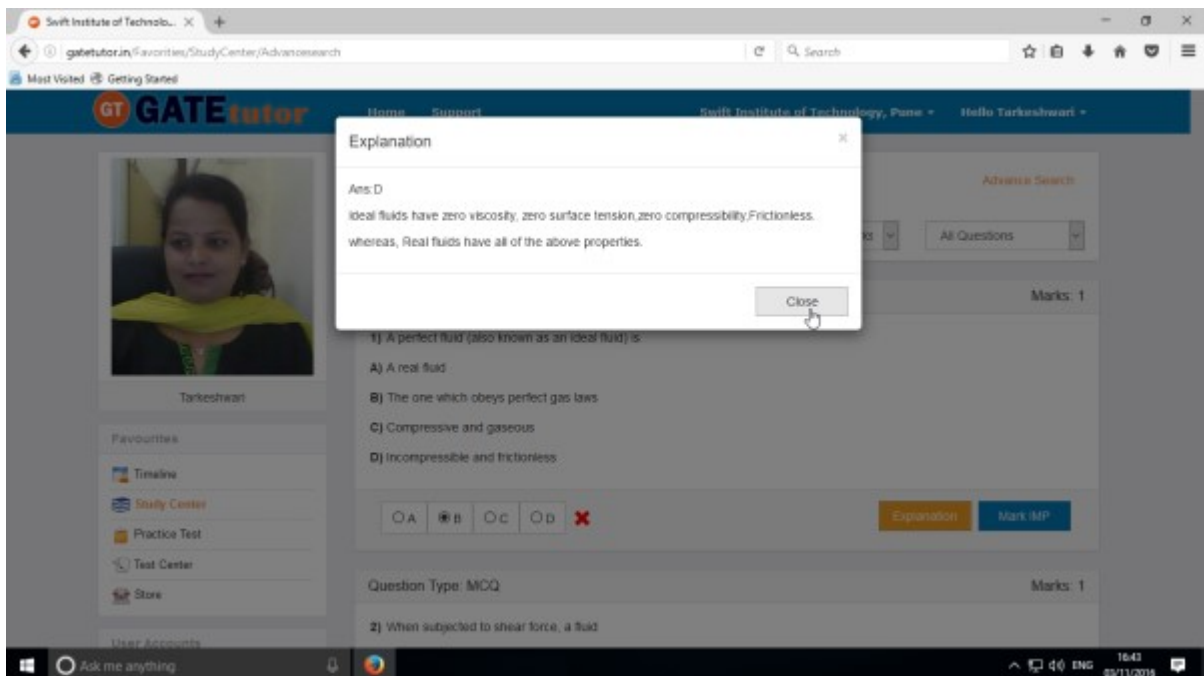


If you have any doubt about the questions, you can also see the explanation by clicking on “**Explanation**” in front of that question on same page.

Choose the doubtful question to see the explanation

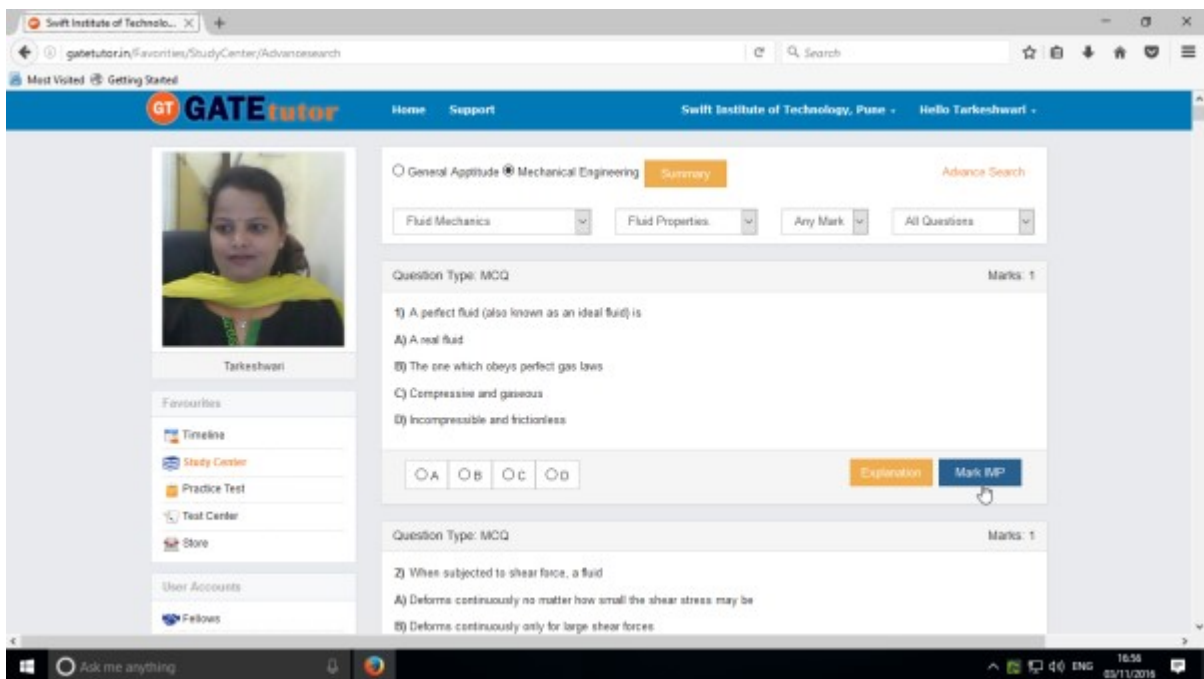


Click on “Explanation”

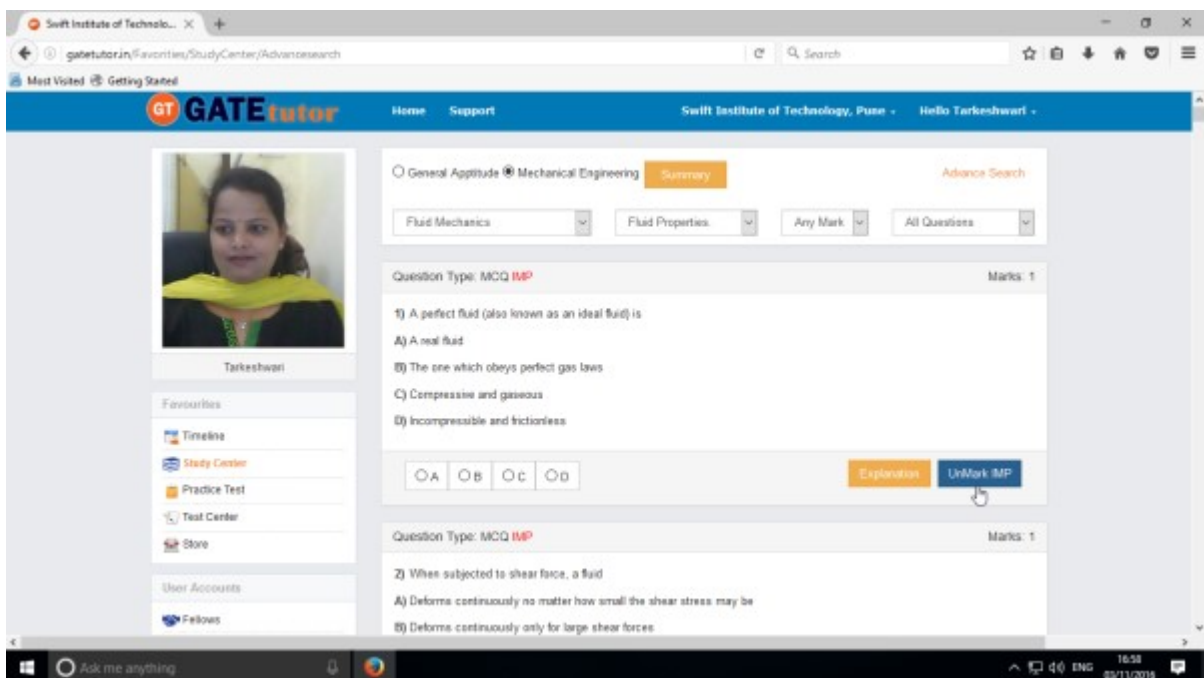

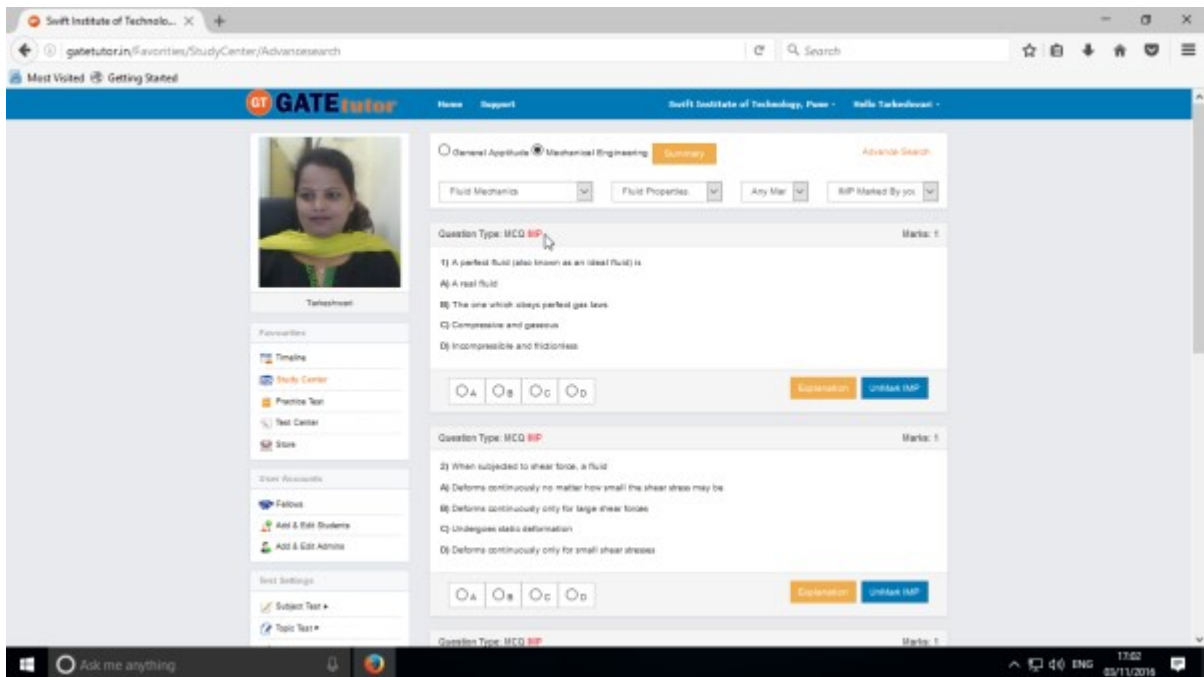
You can sort the questions by their importance or priority also.
If you want to mark the question as an important question then click on “Mark IMP”. It will be seen when you choose option “IMP Marked By you” question format for study.



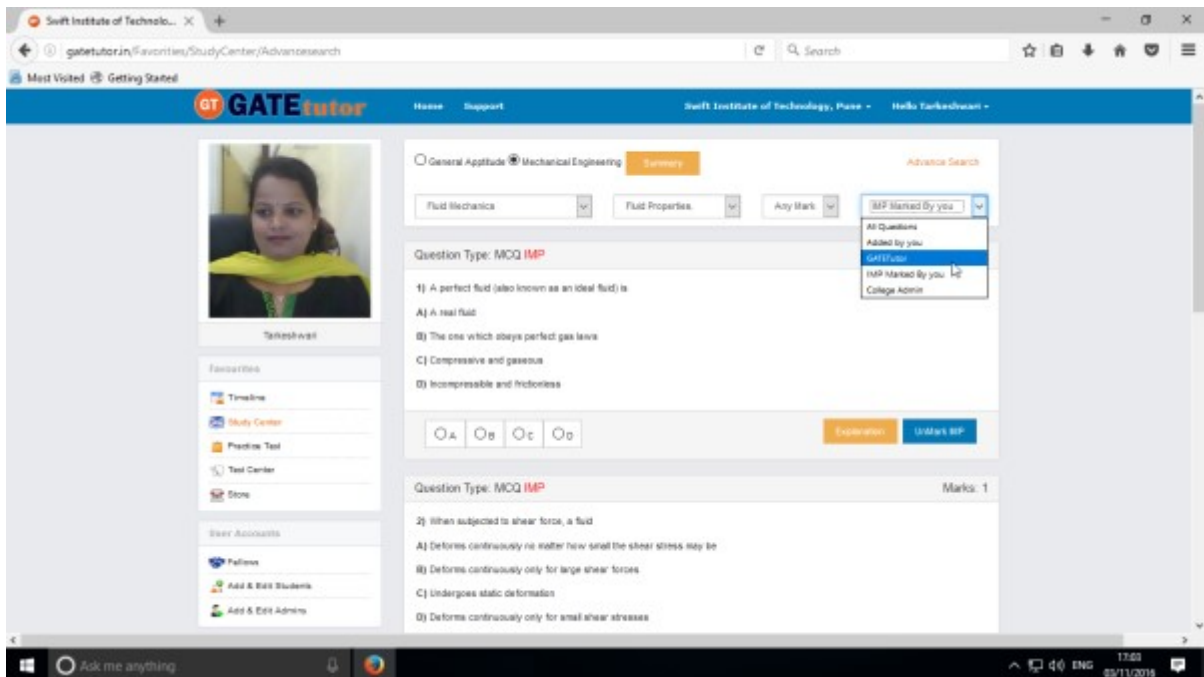
If you want to remove the “Mark IMP” tags from the question just click on the “Unmark IMP”. The Imp mark tag will be removed.

Similarly you can view the questions from other sources as follows.

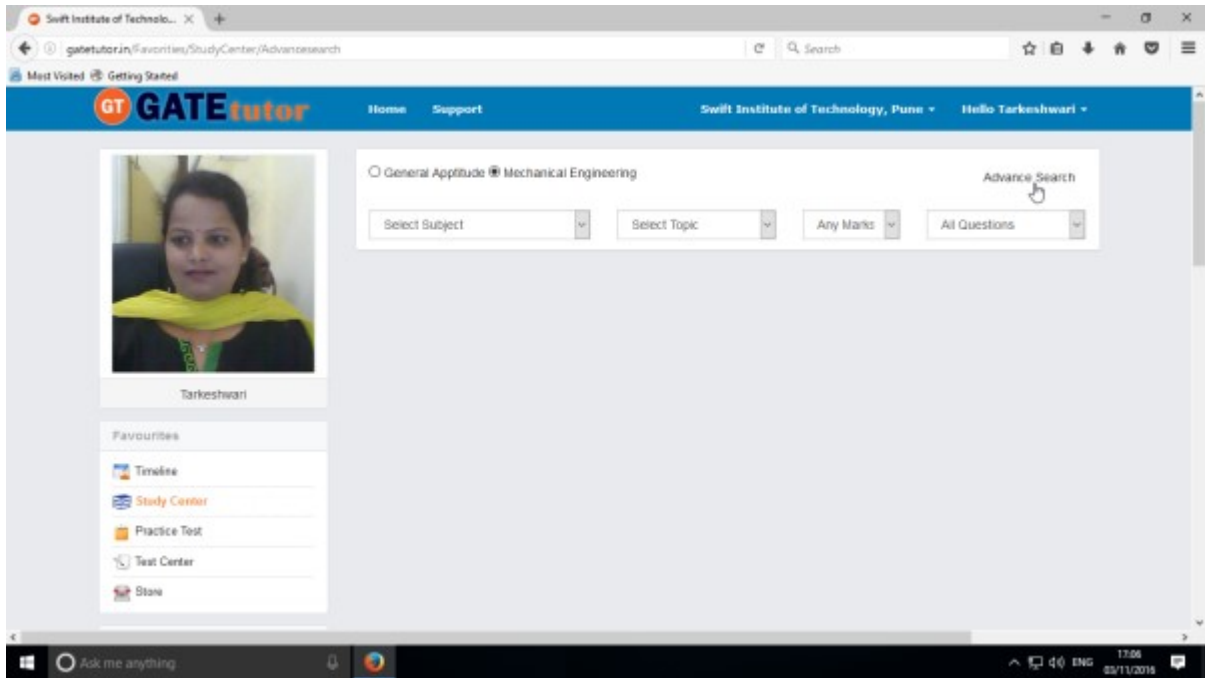


You can choose from multiple types of questions like All Questions, Added By you, GATEtutor, IMP marked by you, College Admin as shown in the figure above.

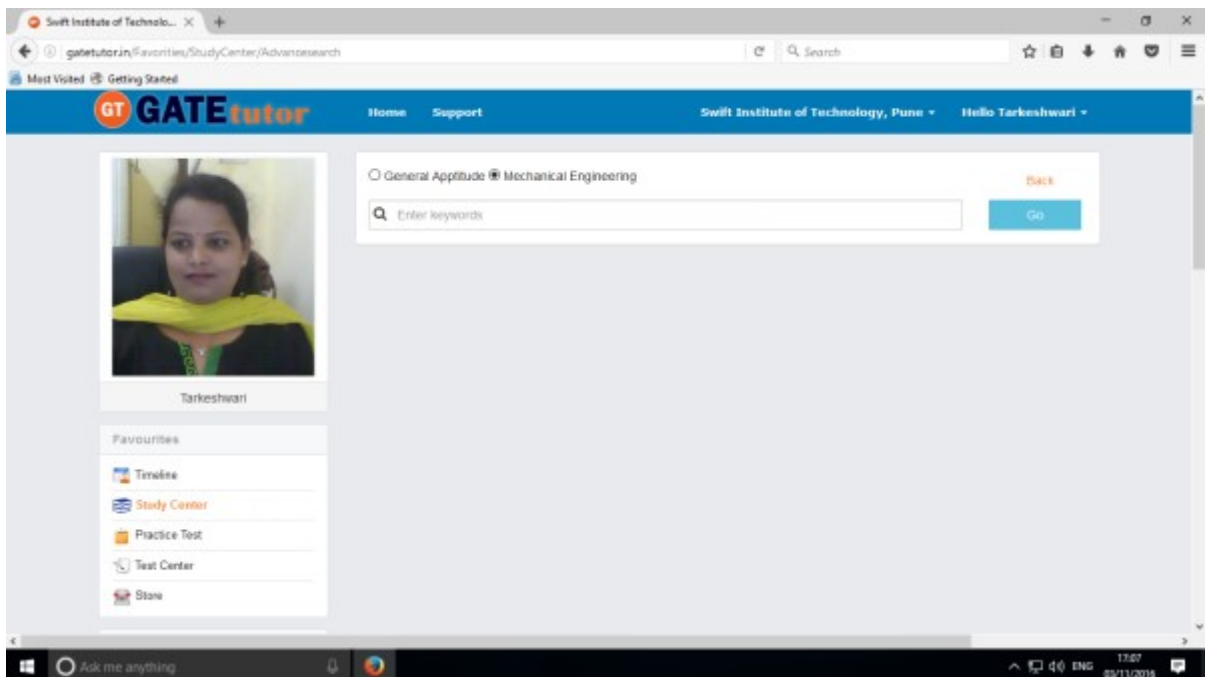
c) Advance Search

If you don't remember the subject & topic in the study center or if you want the questions from random subjects or topics, you can use the "Advance Search".

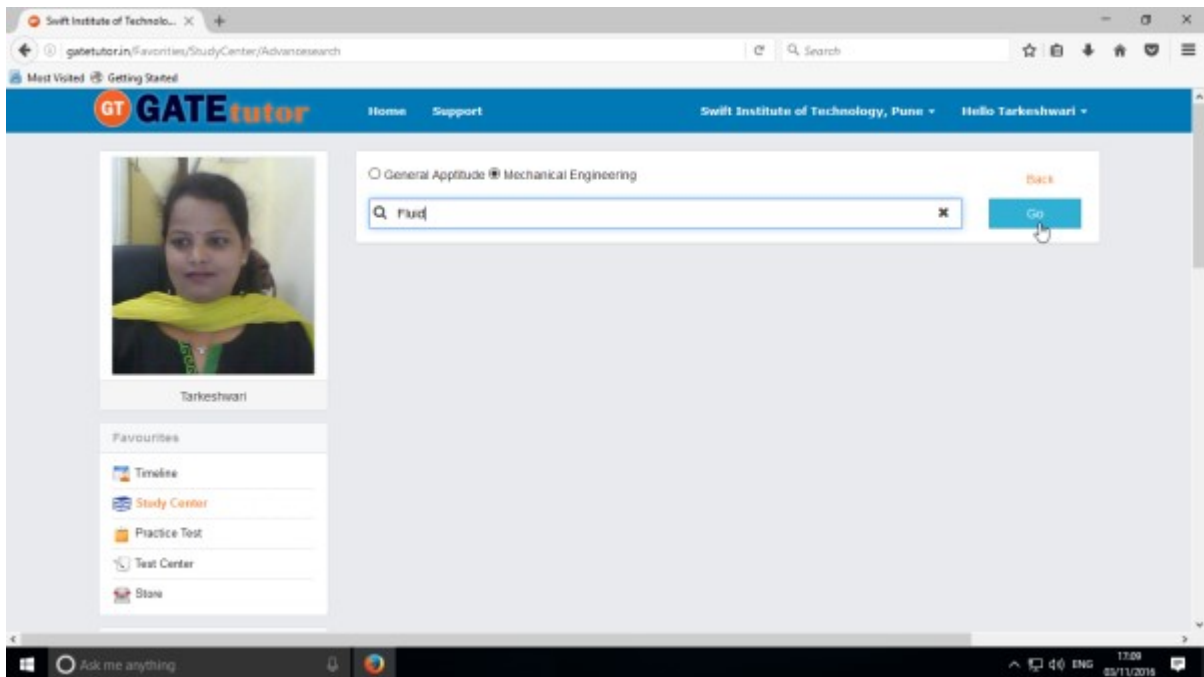
It is a search bar where you have to put just a keyword related to the subject and topic; then whole questions related that keyword will be seen on the screen.



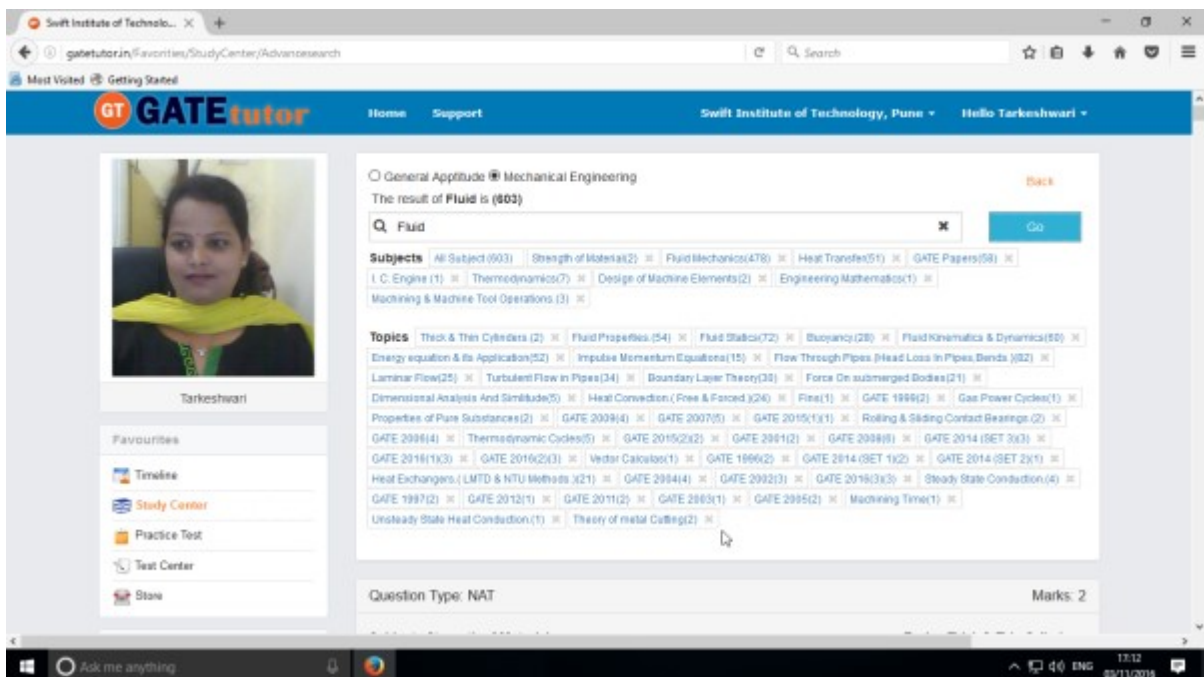
Click on "Advance Search", you will appear following window

You will get all the data related to that keyword like subject, topic & related questions etc.

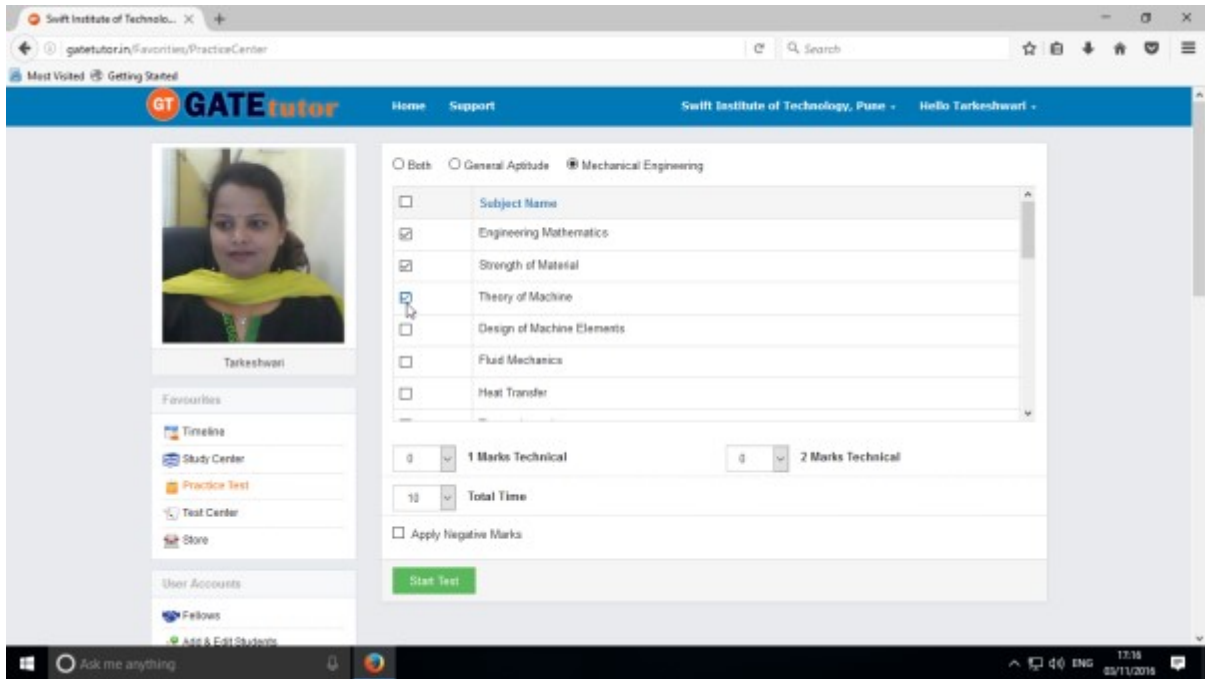


Just click on subjects and topics related to your keyword to check & study the questions.

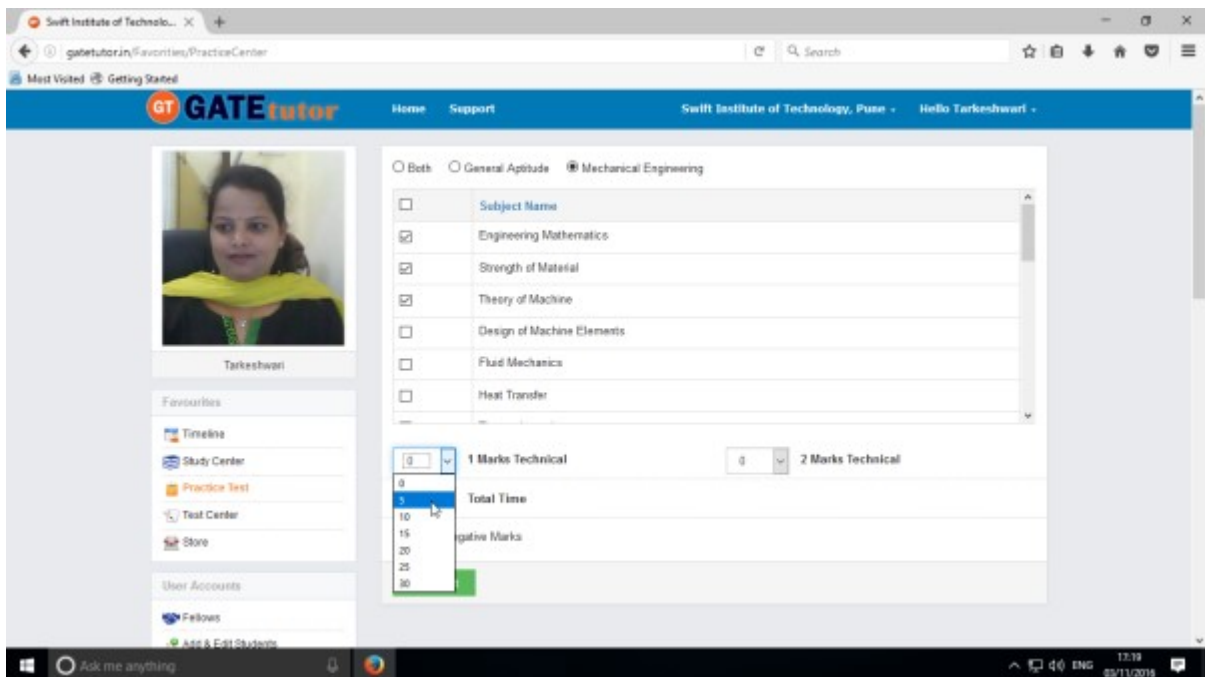
3) Practice Test

Choose subjects on which you want to give a practice test.

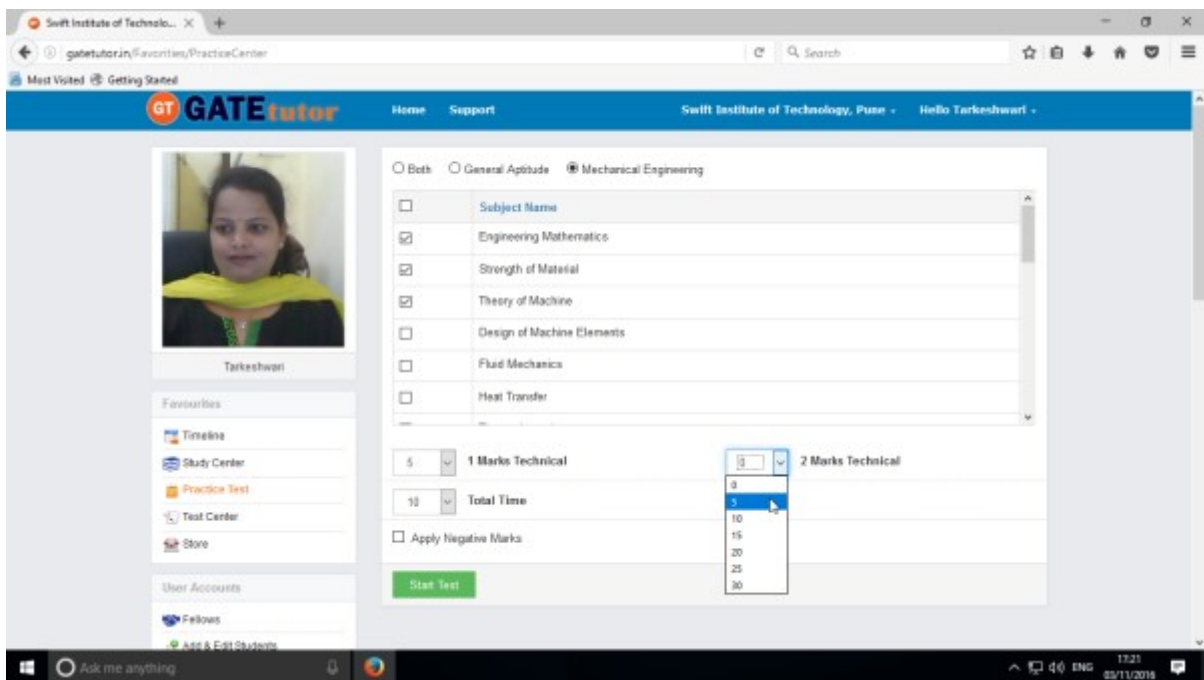


There are two marks options to select mark, “1 Mark Technical” & “2 Marks Technical”.

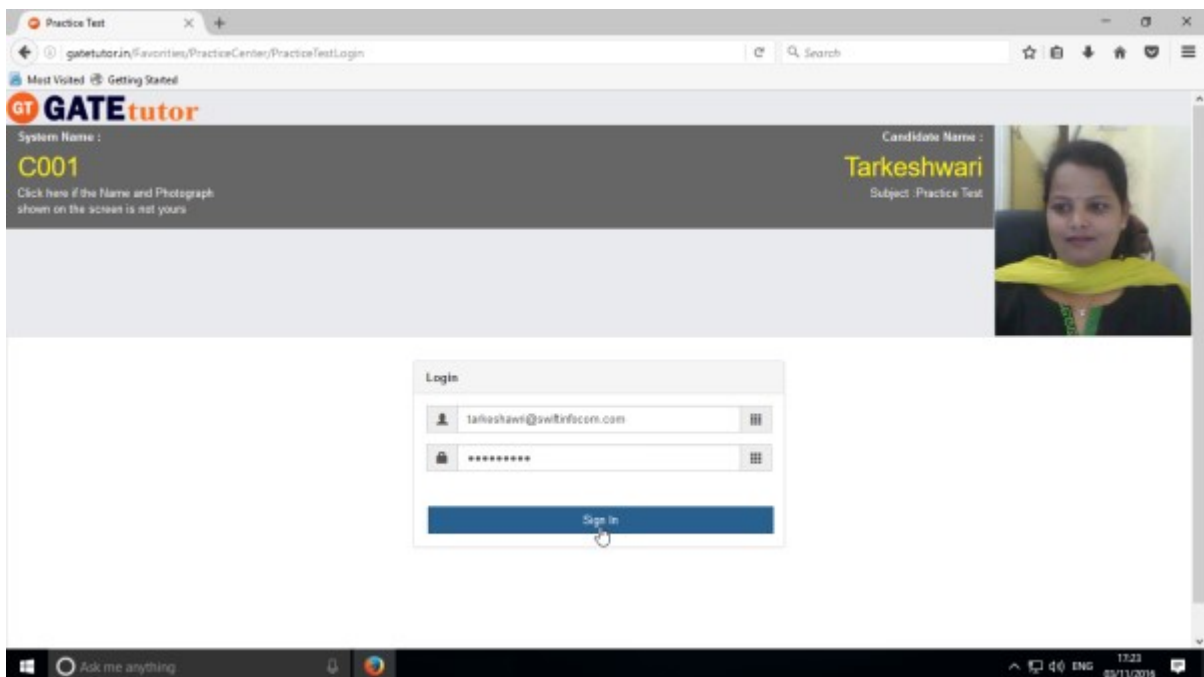


Choose the number of one mark questions as above.

Choose number of two marks questions & select the time as per you want

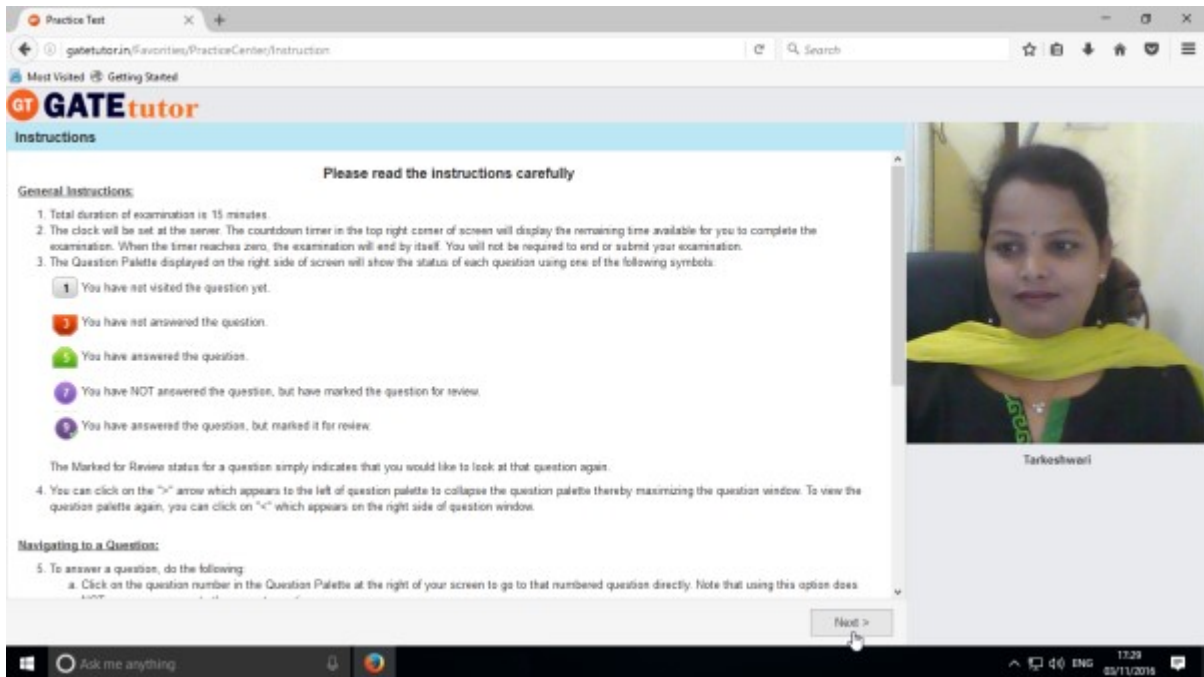

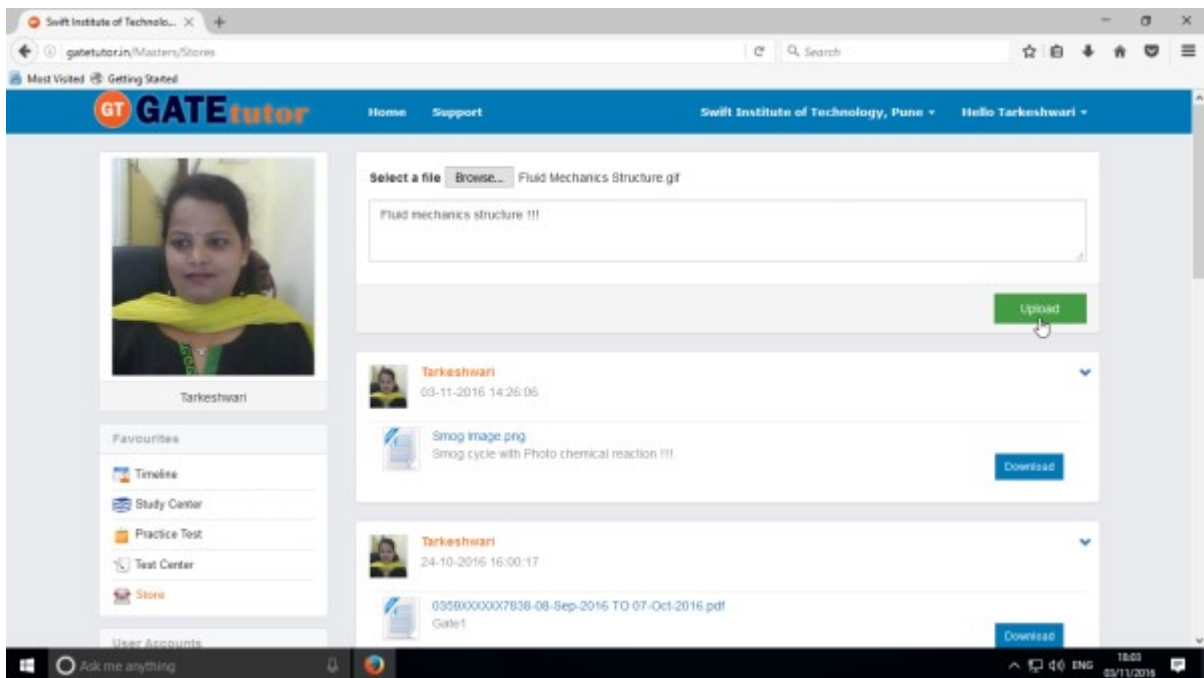

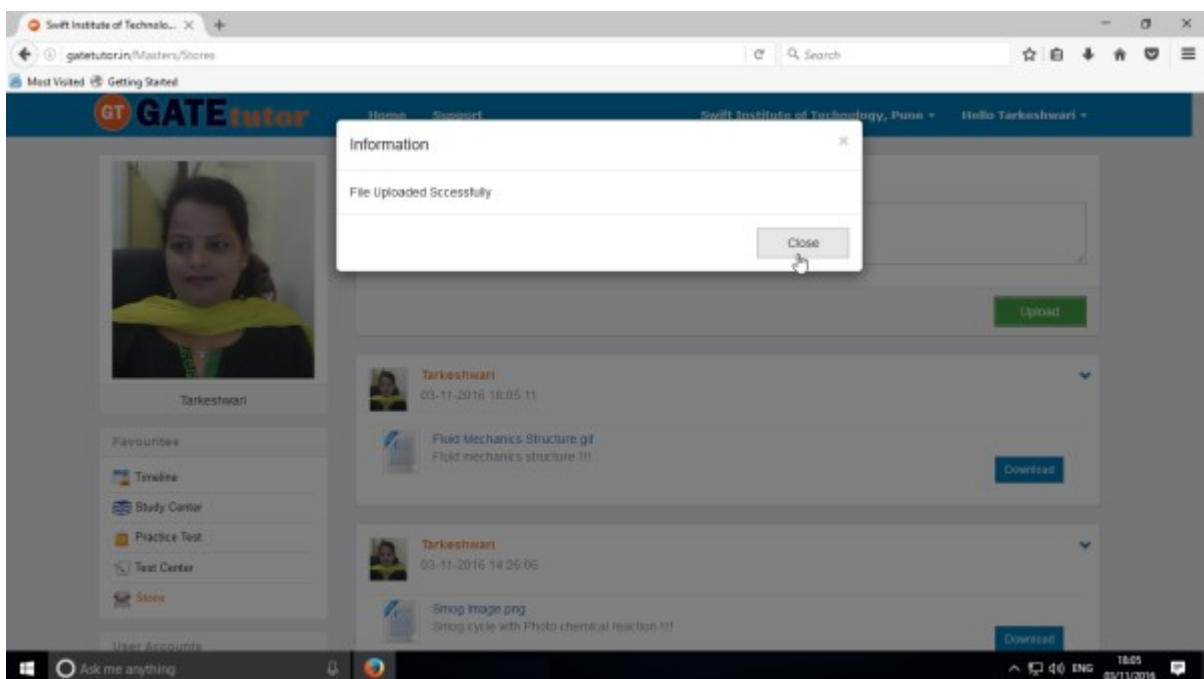
5) Store

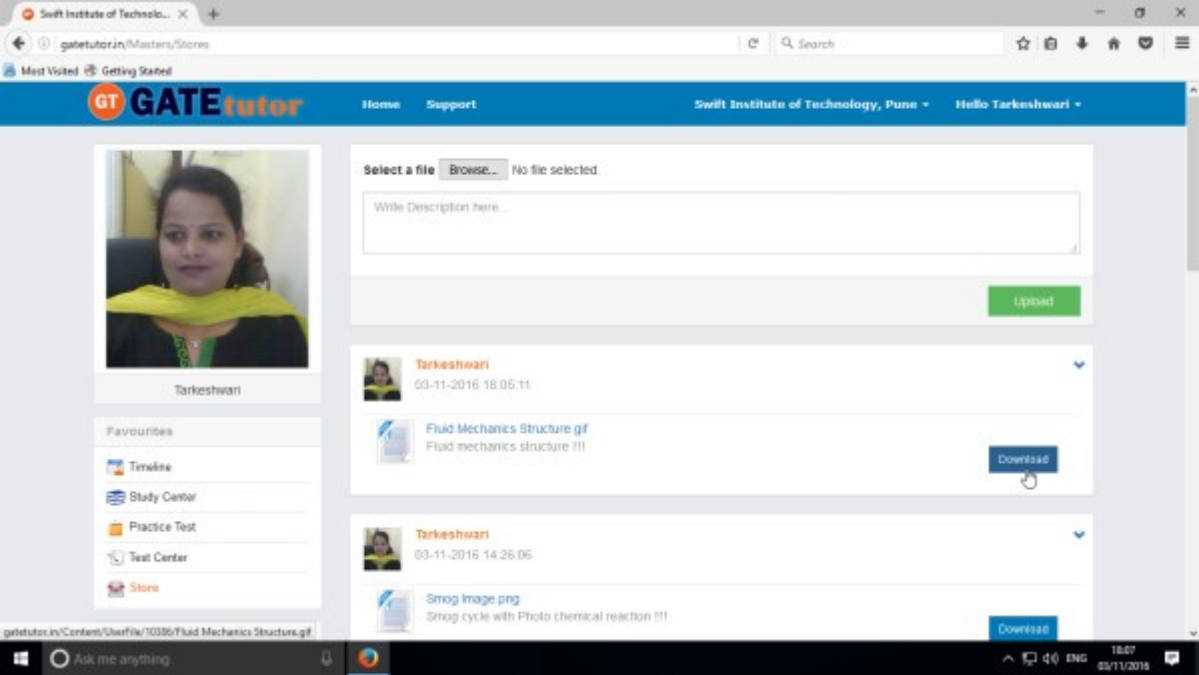
Select (Browse) the file to upload, write the description below for the file & click on “Upload” to upload any file or document.



Click on “Upload” to upload the file. After uploading file successfully click on “Close” to continue.



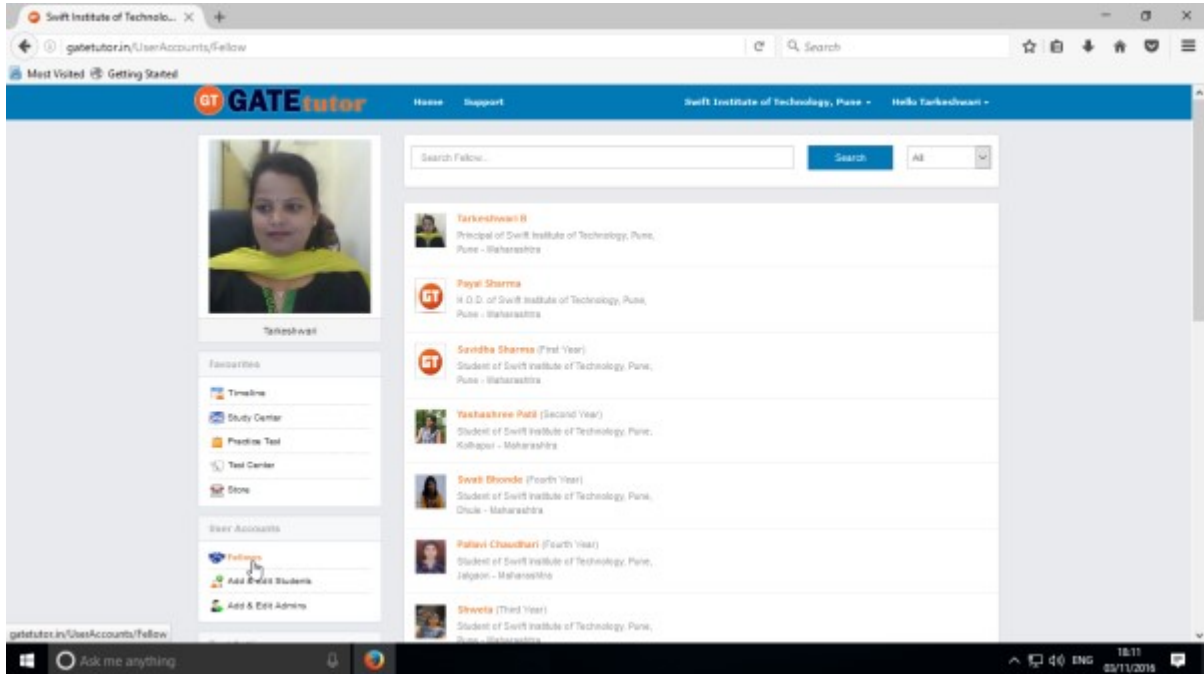

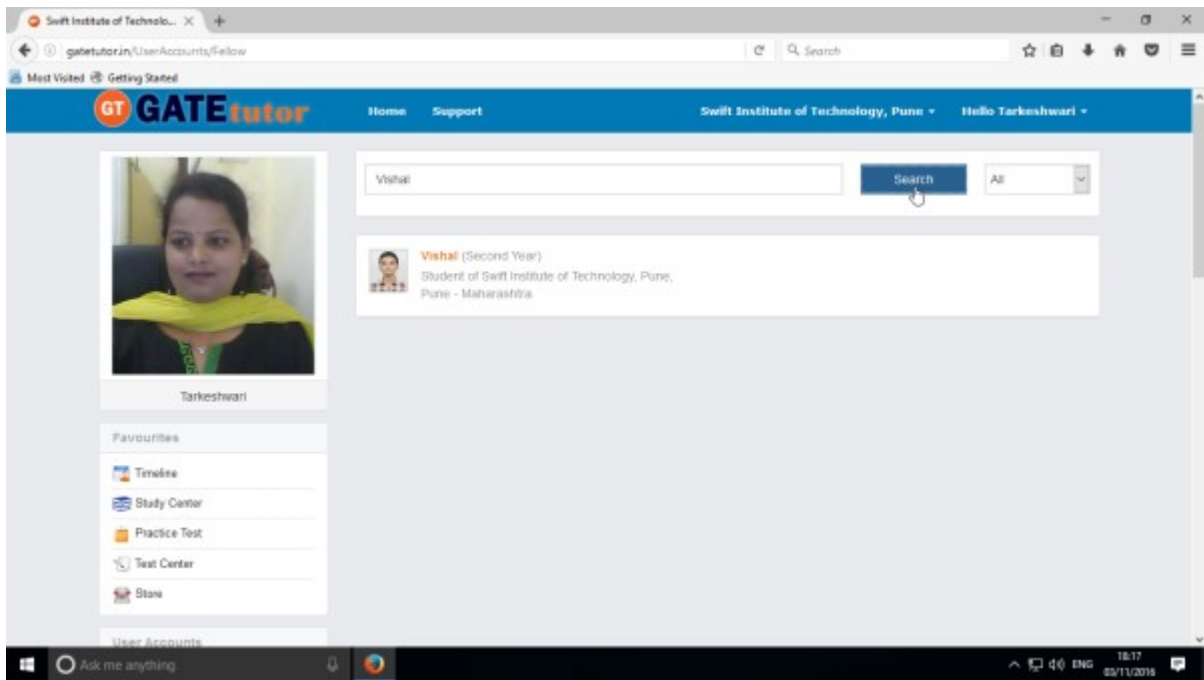

XV. Study Groups

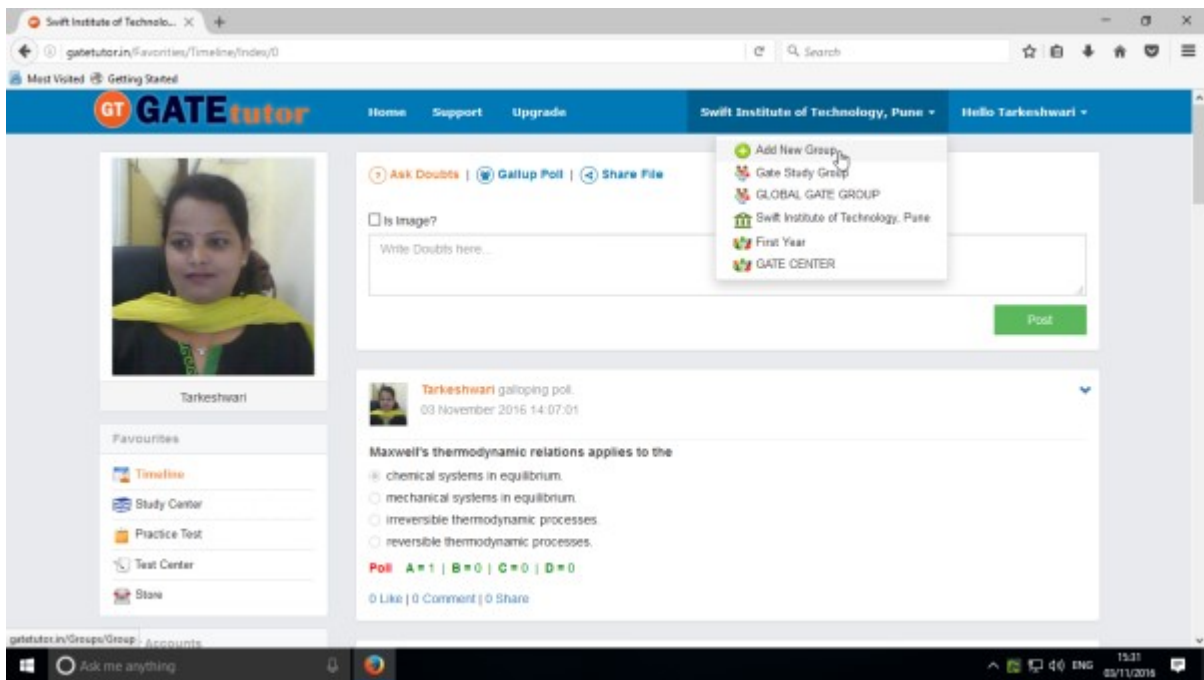
A **study group** is a small group of people who regularly meet to discuss shared fields of study related to GATE online. Admin can create multiple sub groups also.

Sub Group

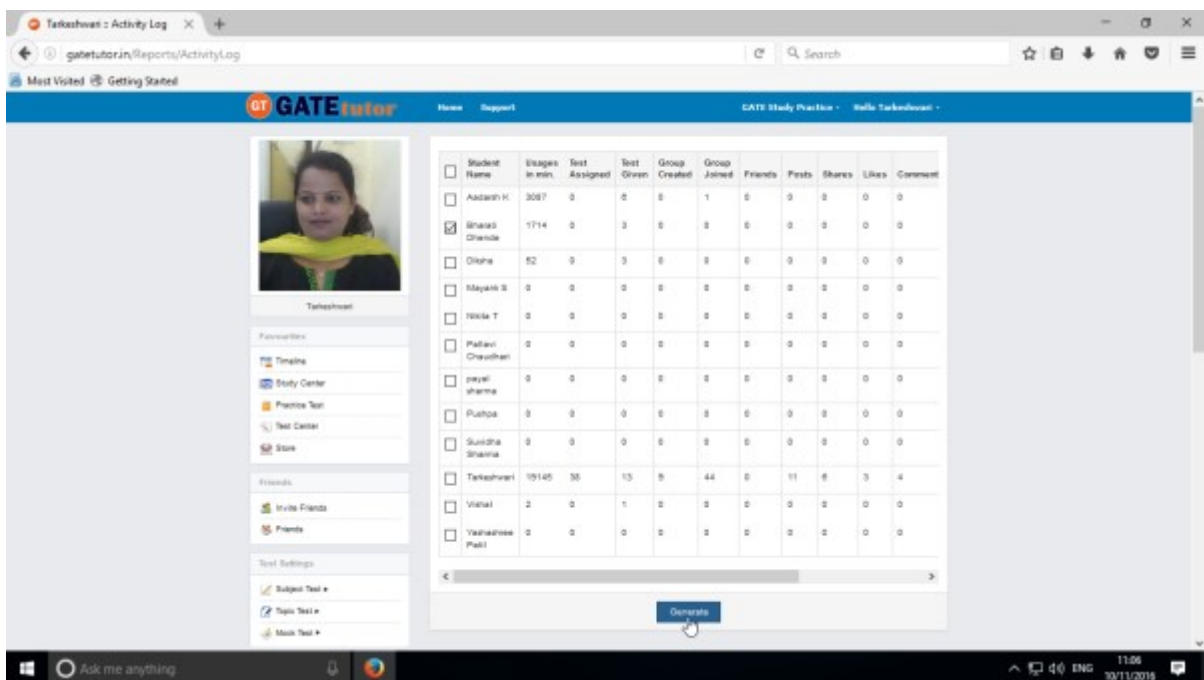

XXIX. Study Groups

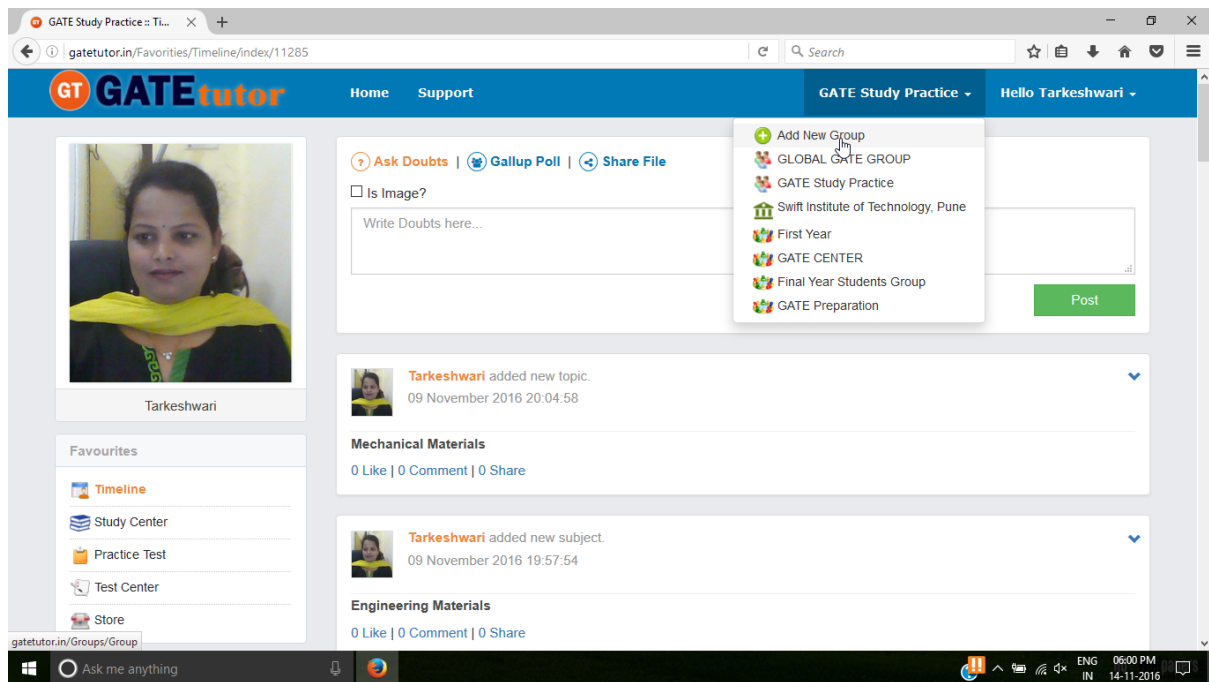
A **study group** is a small group of people who regularly meet to discuss shared fields of study related to GATE online. User can create multiple global groups also.
